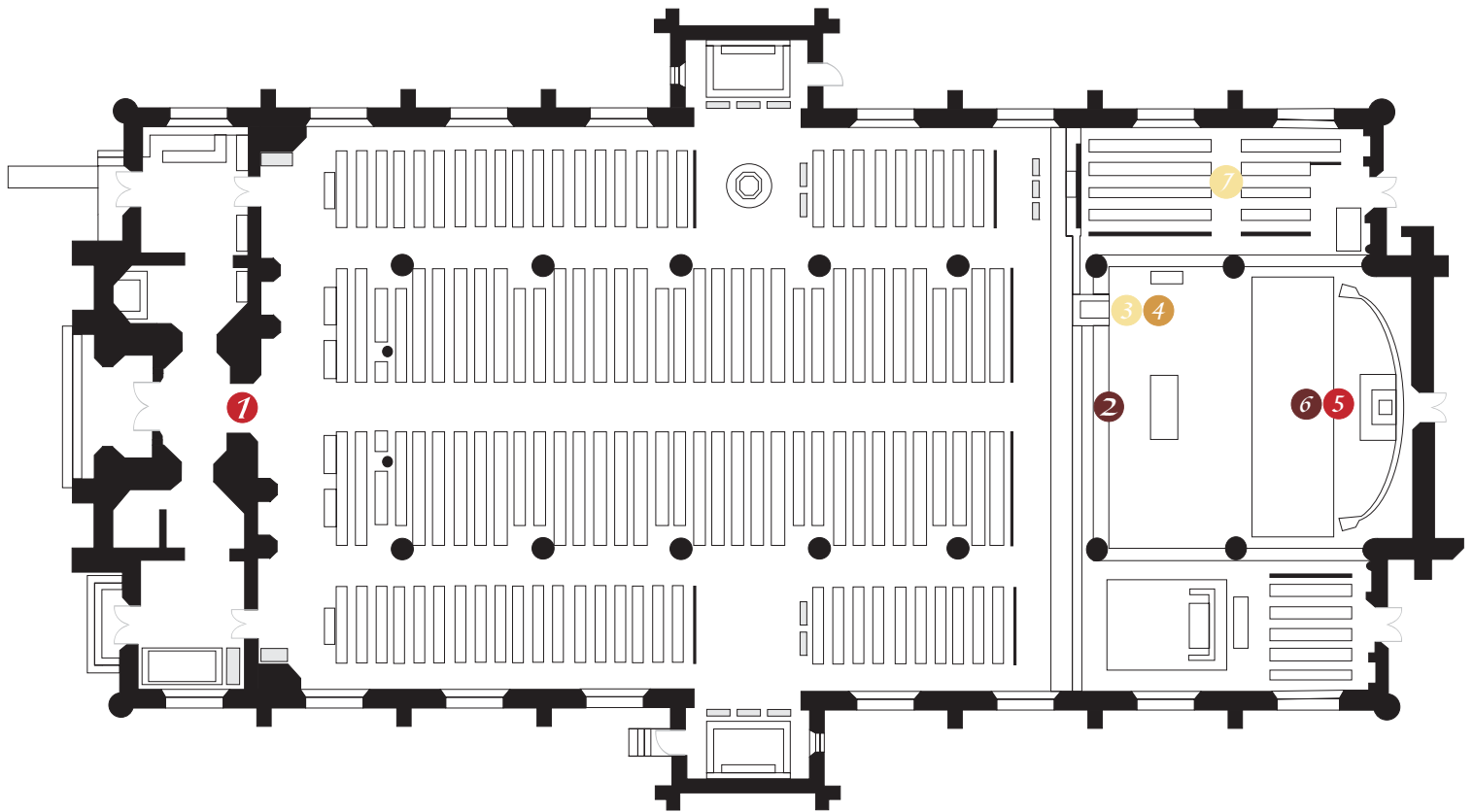




Archbishop Thomas Collins Installation Resources

- 1** Procession to enter the Cathedral. Archbishop Collins is the last Bishop to enter.
- 2** Archbishop Collins will be welcomed to the Cathedral by the rector, Fr. Michael Busch. He holds a cross for the Archbishop to venerate. The Archbishop then blesses the congregation with holy water.
- 3** Father Patrick O'Dea, College of Consultors, vice-chair of Priests' Council, reads the Apostolic Letter.
- 4** Greetings are extended by His Excellency, the Most Reverend Archbishop Luigi Ventura, the Apostolic Nuncio to Canada. Fr. Michael Busch, the rector of the Cathedral, offers greetings on behalf of the Archdiocese.
- 5** Archbishop Collins now takes his seat at the presidential chair. Mass to continue as normal.
- 6** Archbishop Collins gives his first homily as Archbishop of Toronto.
- 7** Music by St. Michael's Choir School, founded in 1937 to facilitate training of a boy's choir for St. Michael's Cathedral.

- Archbishop Collins is the 10th Archbishop since Toronto was made an Archdiocese in 1870.
- There will be 56 Bishops and 3 Cardinals in the sanctuary (altar area) celebrating the installation of Archbishop Collins.
- The Toronto Archdiocese is the largest English Diocese in Canada with 223 parishes and 1.6 million Catholics.
