3. Location

Join us at Villanova College located at 2480 15th Sideroad, King City, ON L7B 0P5.



The day will take place outdoors, on the artificial turf field at the school. Some children's programming and catechesis will take place inside the school.

Washrooms are available inside the school and at field level for those with limited mobility.

Please note: A Day With Mary will be held rain or shine, please plan according to the weather. In case of severe rain or thundershowers, the event will move inside the school.

King City is located between Highways 400 and 404, North of Vaughan. Villanova college is easily accessible and the nearest intersection is that of Keele Street and 15th Sideroad.



4. Parking and Transportation

Parking is free at Villanova College. However, it is very limited. For those arriving by car, you are encouraged to arrive early and our parking attendants will assist in directing you to designated parking lots.

Parishes, religious communities, lay associations and ecclesial movements bringing groups of any size are encouraged to book buses for transportation or arrange for car-pooling. Parking attendants will be on hand to direct automobiles to designated parking lots and buses to loading/unloading zones and will direct you to the designated bus parking location.

5. Registration

For online registration, please visit <u>archtoronto.org/mary</u> to complete your registration.

For large groups (parish, school, lay movements, ecclesial associations, religious communities, etc.) you are welcome to register online or, if more convenient, you are welcome to complete the registration form below and return it by mail. Group registration forms must be received no later than end of day on 19 May 2025. Once registration closes, we will confirm our numbers with our vendors for food, tables and chairs and therefore we will be unable to extend the deadline.

<u>Lunch Orders</u>: We have secured a food vendor to provide lunch for participants. This is optional and comes at a cost of \$10 per meal. Attendees are welcome to bring their own picnic lunch to enjoy if they do not want to purchase lunch. All food orders must be placed in advance at time of registration. Groups are asked to survey members attending and provide final food numbers on the group registration sheet. Payment for this can be done via cheque, submitted at time of registration (one cheque per group, please).

Participants can choose from the following meal options, at a cost of \$10 per meal:

- 1) Grilled 1/2-lb. all beef hamburger + bag of chips + soft drink/water
- 2) Smoked European pork sausage on a bun + bag of chips + soft drink/water
- 3) BBQ jumbo all beef hot dog + bag of chips + soft drink/water
- 4) Grilled veggie burger (vegan/gluten-free patty) + bag of chips + soft drink/water

There will be water refill stations available and participants are encouraged to bring a refillable water bottle in order to stay hydrated.

6. Frequently Asked Questions

• What is a Day With Mary and what can I expect?

A Day With Mary is a one-day, family-friendly, outdoor event where participants will gather together from all corners of the archdiocese to participate in Mass, pray the Rosary, grow deeper in our devotion to Our Lady through a keynote address by Dr. Josephine Lombardi for the adults, powerful witnessings and children's catechesis for the kids.

There will be music, food and fellowship and we hope that you will consider joining His Eminence Frank Cardinal Leo and so many others who love the Blessed Mother.

When is a Day with Mary taking place?

The event will take place May 31, 2025. The day will begin at 10am and end at 4pm. Doors will open at 8:30am.

• Who can attend and is there a cost to attend?

The day is specifically designed to accommodate members of the Catholic community of Toronto of all ages. There will be catechesis and activities for children of all ages, and a keynote address for adults. It is our hope that the day is attended by Catholics young and young at heart!

The event is free for all to attend, lunch is available for purchase at time of registration and is optional – participants are welcome to bring their own picnic lunch to enjoy if they wish. There is also an opportunity to donate to help offset the costs associated with planning an event of this magnitude.

Where is the event taking place?

A Day With Mary will take place at Villanova College located at 2480 15th Sideroad in King City, ON L7B oP5. The majority of the day will take place on the school's football field with some children's programming and washrooms located inside the school.

• Our parish or lay association would like to attend as a group and travel to and from the event on a bus – is this allowed?

While parking is free at Villanova College, there is limited space for parking and as such, not only are groups allowed to take a bus, we highly encourage it! The school has a huge bus loop that we will be using to help facilitate pick up and drop off of attendees, and we have a designated place for busses to park should they be staying for the day.

• I am coming with on my own or with my family, can I drive to this event? Yes, of course. There is limited parking on site, so we encourage you to arrive early in order to park your car and make your way to the field where the event will be taking place.

Our parking lot attendants will help direct you to the nearest parking and once the lot is full at the venue, we have a plan in place to accommodate overflow parking.

• What happens if it rains, will the Day With Mary be rescheduled?

We are planning to hold the event rain or shine – it will not be postponed or rescheduled. Attendees are encouraged to come dressed and prepared for the weather. Suncreen, hats and water should the forecast call for sun and heat; a light jacket and umbrella should the forecast call for light showers.

Should there be significant rainfall and/or thundershowers, we will move the event inside the school building.

How can I register to attend?

Registration is required to attend the event – this is where you can order lunch if you would like (optional) and registering for a Day With Mary allows us to be in communication in advance of the event to provide additional information regarding parking, weather updates, and communicate other important notices about the event.

Registering for a Day with Mary also gives us an idea of how many people will be attending so that we can make the needed arrangements for chair rentals to ensure that everyone has a seat and can fully enjoy the day!
