Welcome to Issue #11 of Family Update, the weekly progress report for the Family of Faith campaign. The campaign has now achieved **24%** of its goal with **\$25,044,582** raised in the Pilot Parish and Leadership Phases.

Pilot Parish "Family Snapshots"

Our Lady of Mount Carmel, Toronto: Father Chin and Father Feng had a very successful commitment weekend raising another **\$34,800**, **25%** of their **\$136,000** goal! To date, they have raised **\$341,890**, and will hold their final Commitment Weekend on Mother's Day weekend!

St. Luke's, Thornhill: Father Burns and his volunteers had an extremely successful week, raising over **\$87,000!** With a total of **\$980,000** raised to date, they are looking forward to the final week of their campaign and hope to reach **\$1 million**.

St. Andrew Kim, North York: Fr. Choi would like to thank all those generous parishioners who have made the Family of Faith campaign such a success. Just before conducting their Commitment Weekend this past weekend, St. Andrew Kim had raised **140%** of their goal, nearly **\$500,000** over goal!

Merciful Redeemer, Mississauga: Fr. Vid Vlasic and his group of volunteers raised nearly **\$80,000** this past week heading into commitment weekend, bringing them to **89%** of their **\$1,565,000** goal. Results from commitment weekend will be seen in the upcoming edition of Family Update.

St. Isaac Jogues, Pickering: After exceeding the campaign goal, the parish still maintains a very strong average gift of nearly **\$7,400**. This will be a very good way to promote the success of the campaign during Commitment Weekend. The volunteers are excited about the possibility of raising **\$1,000,000 or more** for other parish needs.

St. Ann's, Penetanguishene: The parish has now raised more than half of the campaign goal. A group of parishioners have been invited to an orientation meeting where they can learn about the campaign and its progress so far.

Precious Blood, Scarborough: Even in the final weeks of the campaign, Father Murphy continues to receive gifts. Recently, he received another **8** gifts totalling more than **\$20,000**. The parish still has the potential to double their campaign goal next weekend during Commitment Weekend.
