



Campaign Progress

The ten Pilot Phase parishes are wrapping up their campaigns. These parishes received pledges representing **162 per cent** of their **\$7.31** million aggregate goal. The Pilot Phase parishes exceeded their goal by more than **\$4.52 million!**

Wave 1 parishes are still in the early stages of their campaigns with many making significant progress toward their goals. See chart below. The Leadership Phase is also progressing well, with **\$17.41** million raised. The average gift in this phase is almost **\$757,000**.

Overall, the Family of Faith campaign has received **\$30.74 million** or **29 per cent** of its **\$105 million** goal.

Pilot Parish "Family Snapshots"

St. Margaret of Scotland, Toronto: After holding his Major Gift Orientation last week, Fr. Macbeth welcomed 3 new volunteers to the Family of Faith Campaign. This week, they received **5** new pledges for **\$66,000**.

St. Mary of the People, Oshawa: St. Mary of the People has secured **6** pledges totalling **\$88,000**, or **26%** of their goal! Fr. Bollo is excited to see such generous support from the parish as he continues early visits with parishioners.

St. Martin de Porres, Scarborough: Fr. Shea and his Campaign Executive Committee (CEC) have been hard at work the past few weeks, including receiving **8** new gifts this week for **\$49,020**. Fr. Shea is looking forward to hosting his Advance Gift Orientation next week, where he already has some Advance Gift Committee members confirmed.

Cristo Rei and Ss. Salvador Do Mundo, Mississauga: Fr. Macatangga has had tremendous early success and generating momentum with early visits. In the last couple weeks a total of **\$260,000** has been pledged from just **8** gifts, including a **\$75,000** gift!

St. Joseph the Worker, Oshawa: This campaign has now reached **45%** of their **\$465,000** goal. Parishioners have been very generous and Fr. Glowacz hopes the excitement will continue as the parish begins its Advance Phase.

Holy Family, Toronto: Fr. Hilbert and the priests of the oratory are excited to have raised **\$193,000** from only **14** gifts. They and their Campaign Executive Committee are eager to have their Advance Gift Orientation on Monday, July 14, and continue their success in the Advance Phase.



St. Christopher's, Mississauga: Fr. Young was happy to have received the first two gifts of the campaign, totalling **\$55,000**. After a very successful Major Gift Orientation, he and his volunteers are looking forward to starting the Major Phase.

Transfiguration of Our Lord, Etobicoke: Father Van Patten has been working hard at conducting major gift visits. He received his first **\$25,000** gift, creating momentum in moving forward to the Advance Phase of the campaign. He is looking forward to his Advance Phase Orientation on Wednesday, July 16.

Vietnamese Martyrs, Toronto: Father Tran and volunteers have been working extremely hard on completing the Major and Advance Phase visits. With **75%** of his goal raised already, he hopes to reach his archdiocesan goal of **\$230,000** in the upcoming weeks!



St. John Chrysostom, Newmarket: Father Ouellette has had an impressive start to his campaign. He has received **\$127,000** from just four households, including a **\$60,000** gift. With **17%** of the campaign goal already raised Father Bob is on his way toward a very successful campaign.

St. Theresa's, Scarborough: Father Pabilona has been hard at work, having already visited with twelve of his parishioners. Father looks forward to an upcoming Campaign Executive Committee Orientation with **30%** of his campaign goal already raised from just four gifts prior to this meeting.
