



Campaign Progress

Many Wave 1 parishes are making excellent progress toward their goals. Collectively, these parishes have raised donations and pledges totalling **22 per cent** or **\$2.36 million**. Overall, the Family of Faith campaign has received **\$31.66 million** or **30 per cent** of its **\$105 million** goal.

Vietnamese Martyrs, Toronto: Father Tran has been working hard at completing his Advance Phase visits. With **\$202,000** raised to date, he hopes to reach his goal of **\$230,000** in the upcoming weeks!

Holy Family, Toronto: Father Hilbert was happy to announce at his Advance Gift Orientation that he and the priests of the oratory have raised close to **50%** of their archdiocesan goal! He is eager to gather volunteers at the next report meeting to continue the parish's success!

St. John Chrysostom, Newmarket: Father Ouellette held his Campaign Executive Committee (CEC) orientation this past week. The volunteers are eager to visit other parishioners and build upon the early success of the campaign.

Transfiguration of Our Lord, Etobicoke: With a great turnout, Fr. Van Patten and volunteers had their Advance Gift Orientation this past week. With an increase in momentum, they are expecting to expand their team and looking forward to their next report meeting!

St. Paschal Baylon, Thornhill: Fr. Rosato welcomed approximately **35** families this past week to an orientation meeting to learn more about the campaign. Father and his CEC have raised nearly **40%** of their goal in just one week of fundraising.

St. Aidan, Scarborough: Fr. Sultana held his Advance Gift Orientation this past week, coming on the heels of raising **\$43,000** in just the past week. The turnout was great and Fr. Sultana looks forward to welcoming back additional volunteers to his report meeting next week.

St. Mary Star of the Sea, Mississauga: Volunteers were excited to have received the campaign's first three gifts, including a **\$25,000** gift. The CEC looks to build upon their initial success by completing the Major Phase visits in the upcoming weeks.

St. Thomas the Apostle, Markham: With **\$87,900** raised so far, Father Andrews continues to visit with parishioners in the Major Phase, while he and his CEC look forward to the upcoming Advance Gift Orientation.

St. Joseph the Worker, Oshawa: The response from parishioners at St. Joseph the Worker continues to be tremendous, with the parish raising a further **20%** of their goal in the past week. This brings the total raised to just over **\$300,000** towards the goal of **\$465,000!**

Wave 1 Tips

- Planning ahead is one of the keys to a successful parish campaign. Parishes in Wave 1 should now be setting dates and locations for Special Phase Orientations.
- Always schedule follow-up appointments at the visit. This will help to ensure timely gift decisions from donors.
- Speak with conviction; make your own gift before visiting other parishioners.
