



## Campaign Progress

Wave 1 parishes have raised donations and pledges totalling **26 per cent** or **\$2,764,680** of their collective goal. Overall, the Family of Faith campaign has received **\$32.15 million** or **31 per cent** of its **\$105 million** goal.

## Wave 1 Parish "Family Snapshots"

**St. Martin de Porres, Scarborough:** Fr. Shea was pleased to welcome back about 10 parishioners from the previous week's Advance Gift Orientation who will serve on the Advance Gift Committee to meet with fellow parishioners in their phase and to help spread the Family of Faith message.

**St. Margaret of Scotland, Toronto:** Fr. Macbeth and his team of volunteers have been extremely active, meeting with many parishioners. Just this past week, they received **\$50,000** from 3 gifts to their campaign.

After just two weeks, St. Paschal Baylon has already raised **\$416,100** in gifts and pledges, or **43%** of their goal.

**Holy Family, Toronto:** Fr. Martin and volunteers had a great turnout to their first Advance Gift Committee report meeting. With over **\$300,000** raised, they are eager to reach their goal soon!

**Ss. Salvador Do Mundo and Cristo Rei, Mississauga:** The campaign continues to gather great momentum as Fr. Macatangga visits with committed and dedicated parishioners. This past week the parish community raised an additional **\$110,000** from just **6** gifts!

**St. Maria Goretti, Scarborough:** Fr. Galea has been personally visiting members of the CEC in advance of the Major Gift Orientation. He is looking forward to sharing the goals of the campaign with those in attendance this upcoming week.

**St. Thomas the Apostle, Markham:** Fr. Andrews has visited nearly all of his identified parishioners in the Major Phase. He hopes to receive gift decisions as he and the CEC prepare for an Advance Gift Orientation this week to build early momentum for the campaign.

**St. Theresa's, Scarborough:** Fr. Pabilona held his CEC Orientation last week. The parishioners were excited by their success so far. They are looking forward to their Advance Gift Orientation this week, where they will be able to share the goals of the Family of Faith campaign to even more parishioners.
