



## Campaign Progress

Wave 1 parishes have raised donations and pledges to achieve **31 per cent** or **\$3,343,060** of their collective goal. With **298** Wave 1 donors to date, the average gift is **\$11,218**.

Leadership Gifts total **\$17,415,000** from 22 donors, an average gift of almost **\$800,000!**

Overall, the Family of Faith campaign has received **\$32.75 million** or **31 per cent** of its **\$105 million** goal.

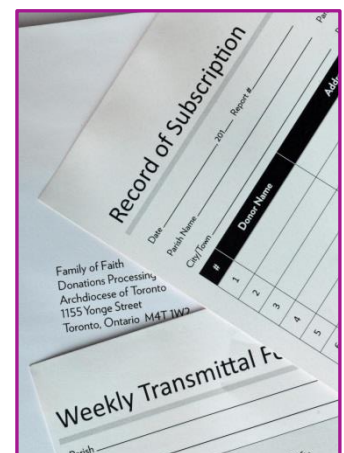
