



Campaign Progress

Wave 1 parishes have raised donations and pledges to achieve **42 per cent** or **\$4.2 million** of their collective goal. Leadership Gifts total **\$17.4 million** from 22 donors. Overall, the Family of Faith campaign has received **\$33.60 million** or **32 per cent** of its **\$105 million** goal.

Wave 1 Parish "Family Snapshots"

St. Paschal Baylon, Thornhill: Fr. Rosato welcomed 9 additional gifts to the campaign last week totalling **\$362,000**, bringing them to **90 per cent** of their \$960,000 goal. Fr. Rosato and his volunteers are looking forward to surpassing their goal in the next couple of weeks.

St. Aidan, Scarborough: Fr. Sultana and his volunteers hosted a Special Phase Orientation last week, where they welcomed 30 new families to learn about Family of Faith. Many of these families have indicated that they will be coming back this week to attend the parish's first phone-a-thon.

Our Lady of Good Health, Scarborough: Fr. Gitendran hosted his Campaign Executive Committee orientation last week and the committee is excited to begin visiting other parishioners at the parish. Fr. Gitendran received his first 4 gifts to the campaign this week, totaling **\$12,600**.

Vietnamese Martyrs, Toronto: Fr. Tran and volunteers were very excited to have reached their archdiocesan goal of **\$230,000** last week! They are excited to enter the Special Phase where **75 per cent** of new funds raised will remain in the parish. With these funds they plan to renovate the basement. Congratulations, Vietnamese Martyrs!

St. Christopher's, Mississauga: Fr. Young and volunteers have been working very hard at securing new volunteers and continuing visits in the Advance Phase. Raising over **\$100,000** in just one week, they are excited to announce their successes to the parish this week.

Holy Family, Toronto: Fr. Hilbert and volunteers have completed many successful Advance Phase visits, with a **96 per cent participation rate** and an average gift of **\$10,000**. With **\$485,500** raised, they are eager to reach their goal of \$495,000 this week!

St. Joseph the Worker, Oshawa: Over the past two weeks, thanks to the generosity and commitment of its dedicated parishioners, St. Joseph the Worker has raised over **\$114,000!** The community is really excited to reach its goal in the coming weeks with only **\$28,400** to go!

Wave 1 Tips

- During phone-a-thons, remember to state that you are calling from the parish and on behalf of the pastor. This will make your fellow parishioner feel more welcomed in having a conversation with you.
- Continue to follow up with parishioners who have gifts pending after about one week. The recommended way to schedule a follow up meeting is to do so during the initial meeting. When setting the time to follow up, it can be as simple as, "I know we met today at 1 p.m. here at the parish. How about we meet at this same time next week for 15 minutes and I can address any other questions that you may have before you document your decision?"
