



Campaign Progress

Collectively, Wave 1 parishes have now raised almost \$5 million in donations and pledges. That's 50 per cent of the total Wave 1 goal. Congratulations to hardworking pastors and volunteers who have really embraced the Family of Faith campaign. The average gift in Wave 1 is over \$10,000. Overall, the Family of Faith campaign has received **\$33.82 million** or **33 per cent** of its **\$105 million** goal.
