Campaign Progress

Collectively, Wave 1 parishes have now raised more than \$5.5 million in donations and pledges. That's 55 per cent of the total Wave 1 goal. Overall, the Family of Faith campaign has received **\$35.34 million** or **34 per cent** of its **\$105 million** goal.

Wave 1 Parish “Family Snapshots”

St. Joseph the Worker, Oshawa: Fr. Glowacz and the campaign volunteers are pleased to report that another **6** gifts totalling **\$51,800** have been secured over the past week. This means that the parish has exceeded its goal of **\$465,000!** Congratulations to all the dedicated parishioners who have made this possible.

St. Mary of the People, Oshawa: The parish was glad to receive another **\$33,500** in pledges, raising **10%** of their goal in one week! Fr. Bollo also welcomed 21 families to the Special Gift Phase Orientation this past week. Families at the orientation were excited to hear about the important renovations planned for the parish hall with its local parish share.

St. Margaret of Scotland, Toronto: Fr. Macbeth welcomed 10 additional volunteers last week from his Advance Gift Orientation who will begin scheduling visits with other parishioners in the Advance Gift Phase of the campaign. Fr. Macbeth also received **6** gifts totalling **\$69,600** last week.

St. Martin de Porres, Scarborough: Fr. Shea and his team of volunteers began their phone-a-thons last week. As a result of their efforts, **10** new gifts were received last week, making it the 5th parish in Wave 1 to receive 50 or more gifts.

Our Lady of Good Health, Scarborough: Fr. Gitendran and his Campaign Executive Committee have been personally visiting with parishioners in the past couple of weeks. Just last week, they secured **3** additional gifts for **\$18,000**, bringing them to **30%** of their goal after just a couple of weeks of active fundraising.

St. John Chrysostom, Newmarket: Fr. Ouellette delivered the public announcement last weekend, and kicked off the public phase of the parish’s campaign with a strong public relations initiative. St. Thomas the Apostle, Markham: Deacon Everis Munroe and General Chair Coleen Ladd made over 40 Major Gift Phase follow up visits, helping to secure **\$54,100** from **11** gifts in new pledges for the parish, raising more than **10%** of the parish’s goal in one week!
