Campaign Progress

Collectively, Wave 1 parishes have now raised almost \$6.4 million in donations and pledges. That's an amazing 64 per cent of the total Wave 1 goal and huge increase over last week. Overall, the Family of Faith campaign has received **\$36.22 million** or **34 per cent** of its **\$105 million** goal. The total raised includes pledges and donations from members of our clergy who have sacrificially committed to the Family of Faith campaign. To date, clergy have committed **\$660,000**.

Wave 1 Parish “Family Snapshots”

Transfiguration of Our Lord, Etobicoke: Fr Van Patten and parish volunteers had a great turn out to their Special Gift Orientation last week, with more than 20 families attending. With close to **50%** of their goal raised, they are eager to begin the Special Phase of the campaign.

St. Mary Star of the Sea, Mississauga: Fr. McMillan and campaign volunteers are working hard and visiting many parishioners in both the Advance and Major Phases. In just one week, they have raised over **\$50,000**.

St. Christopher's, Mississauga: Fr. Young and his volunteers were excited to welcome parishioners to their Special Gift Orientation last week and announce another successful week, raising over **\$90,000**. They are looking forward to beginning the phone-a-thons this week to start the final phase of their campaign.

Holy Family, Toronto: Fr. Hilbert and parish volunteers welcomed parishioners to their Special Gift Orientation last week. With phone-a-thons beginning this week, they are looking forward to the final weeks of their campaign, now that they are over goal and 75% of additional funds received will stay with the parish.

St. Martin de Porres, Scarborough: Fr. Shea was happy to welcome 15 volunteers to join in to help the parish with its second phone-a-thon last week. During calls, over **\$50,000** was raised over the phone.

St. John XXIII, Don Mills: Fr. de Gale received **12** new gifts to the campaign last week, more than doubling his total up until that point. Fr. de Gale is looking to achieve his parish goal in order to replace the church's old furnace.

St. Aidan, Scarborough: Ten parish callers attended a phone-a-thon last week to follow up on letters to parishioners sent from Fr. Sultana requesting participation in the campaign. Just in the past week, **17** additional pledges were received for more than **\$60,000!**

St. Mary of the People, Oshawa: As the Special Phase begins at the parish, Fr. Bollo and his campaign volunteers are pleased to see that another **\$46,700** has been pledged to the campaign. This puts the campaign just over **\$200,000!**

Our Lady of Fatima Shrine, Scarborough – The parish's Advance Phase Gift Committee conducted 20 new visits last week, nearly concluding all visits in that phase of their campaign. They are eager to make follow up visits to receive decisions, as the Special Phase of the campaign kicks off this week.

St. John Chrysostom, Newmarket – Fr. Ouellette and volunteers were happy to announce that the parish raised **\$88,000** last week, more than doubling the amount pledged the previous week.
