Campaign Progress

Collectively, Wave 1 parishes have now raised almost **\$7.13 million** in donations and pledges. Overall, the Family of Faith campaign has received **\$37 million** or **35 per cent** of its **\$105 million** goal.

Wave 1 Parish “Family Snapshots”

St. Thomas the Apostle Parish, Markham: Father Andrews, the Campaign Executive Committee, and Advance Gift Committee are proud to announce that they have reached **75%** of goal this week. This is a fantastic achievement for the parish as it embarks on the Special Phase.

St. Theresa, Scarborough: Father Pabilona received key pledges this week, bringing the total raised at the parish to **\$210,500**, taking the parish over its **\$205,000** goal.

Holy Family, Toronto: Father Hilbert and volunteers are working hard to conduct phone-a-thons. They are looking forward to the final week of their campaign, and excited to see the results of their upcoming Commitment Weekend.

Vietnamese Martyrs, Toronto: Father Tran is excited to have completed his final week of the campaign. Over goal, and receiving **75%** of funds back to the parish, he hopes to have a successful Commitment Weekend to raise funds for the parish’s basement renovations.

St. John XXIII, Don Mills: Last week at their Special Gift Orientation, Fr. de Gale and volunteers welcomed more than **60** people to learn more about the Family of Faith campaign. In just over a month of active fundraising, they have raised over **60%** of their goal.

St. Paschal Baylon, Thornhill: Even though they have already surpassed their goal, Fr. Rosato and his group of volunteers have still been active and personally visiting with parishioners. Last week they raised over an additional **\$50,000**, bringing them to nearly **\$1.15** million in pledges.

St. Mary of the People, Oshawa: Parishioners are responding very positively to the campaign needs, having pledged an additional **\$34,000** over the past week! St. Mary of the People is now **69%** towards their goal of **\$345,000!**

Cristo Rei and Ss. Salvador do Mundo, Mississauga:

Volunteers have been hard at work, visiting parish families over the past couple weeks explaining the case and parish needs. Parishioners have responded with tremendous support, with **\$82,500** being pledged in the past week from **8** gifts!
