



Campaign Highlights

Collectively, Wave 1 parishes have now raised almost **\$8 million** in donations and pledges. Overall, the Family of Faith campaign has received **\$37.8 million** or **36 per cent** of its **\$105 million** goal.

Thanks to all of the Wave 2 pastors and volunteers who attended our orientation sessions last week. The sessions were well attended and we received much positive feedback. St. Martin de Porres, Scarborough: During their last week of fundraising, Fr. Shea and volunteers were able to raise more than **\$40,000**, mostly through their final phone-a-thon. Fr. St. Aidan, Scarborough: Through phone-a-thons over the last few weeks, Fr. Sultana and his team of volunteers were able to reach **98%** of their goal as of last week. Holy Family, Toronto: Fr. Hilbert and volunteers have been hard at work, and have completed their phone-a-thons. They are looking forward to sharing their results from this past weekend's Commitment Weekend.

St. Mary Star of the Sea, Mississauga: Fr. McMillan and volunteers welcomed **15** families to their Special Gift Orientation and recruited **8** more parishioners to their team of volunteers. They are looking forward to beginning phone-a-thons and hope to complete their Advance Phase in the upcoming weeks.

St. Thomas the Apostle, Markham: St. Thomas the Apostle kicked off its Special Phase last week, after reaching **86%** of goal, or **\$450,000**. Nearly all Major & Advance Phase parishioners have been visited, so the Special Phase Gift Committee has the task of challenging the remainder of the parish to make the goal.

Our Lady of Sorrows, Etobicoke: Fr. Cavoto recently welcomed his first three gifts to the campaign. Each household understood the necessary sacrifice required to realize the parish and archdiocese's most pressing priorities.
