



## Campaign Progress

Collectively, Wave 1 parishes have now raised over **\$8.8 million** in donations and pledges. Overall, the Family of Faith campaign has received **\$38.8 million** or **37 per cent** of its **\$105 million** goal.

Seven parishes in Wave 1 have now exceeded their goal!

## Wave 1 Parish "Family Snapshots"

**St. Martin de Porres, Scarborough:** On the weekend of September 13-14, Fr. Shea held his Commitment Weekend and received an additional 137 gifts for **\$316,330**. With this, St. Martin de Porres became the first parish in Wave 1 to surpass 200 gifts to its campaign and has now raised **\$743,010** on its goal of **\$435,000**. Congratulations!

**St. Aidan's, Scarborough:** Last week, through phone-a-thons and following up with pending parishioners, St. Aidan received **6** pledges for an additional **\$9,930** pledged. This was able to propel them above their goal of **\$300,000**. Job well done Fr. Sultana and all the volunteers at St. Aidan's!

**St. John Chrysostom, Newmarket:** Volunteers at St. John Chrysostom are making a concerted effort to finish all Advance Phase visits prior to Commitment Weekend at the parish. As a sacrificial gift of their time, Major Gift Committee Members have re-joined the campaign effort to bolster activity in the phase.

**Holy Family, Toronto:** Fr. Hilbert and volunteers were very excited to have raised an additional **\$136,300** towards their **\$495,000** goal. They have successfully completed their campaign with a total of raised of **\$746,120**. Holy Moly! Congratulations, Holy Family!

**St. Mary Star of the Sea, Mississauga:** Fr. McMillan and volunteers were very excited to have raised **\$62,000** in just one week, bringing their total to **\$187,800**! With **46%** of their goal raised, they are eager to continue their success throughout the remainder of the campaign!
