



Campaign Progress

Terrific news! Over this past weekend (September 27-28) important Family of Faith campaign milestones were met. As of Monday, September 29th, the Feast of St. Michael, the campaign surpassed **\$40 million**. In addition, collectively, Wave 1 parishes have exceeded **100 per cent** of their goal. 14 of these 20 parishes have now reached or surpassed their individual goals, which also means they will receive **75 per cent** of donations over their goals!

Wave 1 Parish “Family Snapshots”

St. Joseph the Worker, Oshawa: On the weekend of September 13-14, Fr. Glowacz held his Commitment Weekend. Even though they were already over their goal of **\$465,000**, they received an additional **88** gifts to their campaign on that weekend, bringing their overall raised to **\$691,445**. Congratulations and job well done, St. Joseph the Worker!

St. Mary the People, Oshawa: On September 20-21, Fr. Bollo held his Commitment Weekend and garnered **45** gifts for an additional **\$76,680**. This brings their total raised to **\$369,595** and they have now surpassed their goal! Way to go!

St. Thomas the Apostle, Markham: Last week, through a combination of phone-a-thons and follow up visits, volunteers at St. Thomas the Apostle were able to raise an additional **\$35,800** to put the parish over its goal of **\$515,000**, bringing the total raised to **\$520,068**. An exciting accomplishment as Commitment Weekend approaches!

Our Lady of Fatima Shrine, Scarborough: While Fr. Victor Mallia leads a pilgrimage to Rome, volunteers have kicked into high gear on the campaign to ensure that campaign activity continues in the pastor’s absence. Because of their efforts, the parish received **\$50,000** in new pledges this week. With two weeks to go until Commitment Weekend, Our Lady of Fatima Shrine is in an excellent position for a strong finish to the campaign.

St. Paschal Baylon, Thornhill: Fr. Rosato and volunteers received an additional **\$38,470** in gifts this past week. Already being nearly **\$300,000** over goal, St. Paschal Baylon parish is looking forward to receiving even more gifts during their Commitment Weekend this weekend.

Ss. Salvador Do Mundo and Cristo Rei, Mississauga: Fr. Macatangga and his team have now surpassed its goal of **\$720,000**! He received an additional **\$161,500** from **21** gifts to the campaign during the past week. Great work!

St. Christopher's, Mississauga: While Fr. Young was away on vacation, volunteers were excited to have raised over **\$145,000** in a single week! With **\$763,520** raised, they have exceeded their archdiocesan goal of **\$750,000**, and are excited to report the results of their Commitment Weekend in next week’s edition of Family Update!

St. Mary Star of the Sea, Mississauga: Fr. McMillan and volunteers have been conducting visits in the Advance Phase while also carrying out phone-a-thons. Their diligence paid off this week when the team raised over **\$112,000**! With a total raised of **\$312,000**, they are eager to raise the remaining **25%** of their goal in the upcoming weeks.
