Wave 1 Parish “Family Snapshots”

Transfiguration of Our Lord, Etobicoke: Fr. Van Patten and volunteers were excited to have raised a total of **\$119,290** during their Commitment Weekend. With a total of **\$457,170** raised, they are happy to be able to use their share of the funds to replace boilers and repave their parking lot. Great job!

St. Christopher's, Mississauga: Fr. Young and volunteers had an extremely successful Commitment Weekend, raising an additional **\$240,125!** With over **\$1 million** raised, they will use their share of funds to hire a youth minister, support their local Compass food bank and provide aid to their school in Haiti. Congratulations, St. Christopher's!

St. Aidan's, Scarborough: Through their Commitment Weekend, Fr. Sultana was able to welcome **105** new gifts to the campaign for **\$223,720**. This now brings their total raised to **\$536,104**, or **179%** of goal. Congratulations and a job well done to Fr. Sultana and all of the volunteers.

Our Lady of Good Health, Scarborough: Fr. Gitendran and volunteers held their Commitment Weekend on September 27 & 28, raising an additional **\$130,850**. The parish surpassed its goal! Volunteers have been hard at work over the past few months visiting with their fellow parishioners to share the pillars of the Family of Faith campaign. This effort has led them to end up at having raised **\$229,050**.

St. John XXIII, Don Mills: Under the leadership of Fr. de Gale, St. John XXIII was able to raise nearly **\$160,000** on their Commitment Weekend, bringing them to **175%** of goal! Now that they have well surpassed their goal, the parish can not only replace its church boiler, but it also can do other things around the parish such as repaving the parking lot and putting in a fence around their property. Way to go!

Cristo Rei and Ss. Salvador do Mundo, Mississauga: As the campaign has recently launched throughout the parish, volunteers have conducted their first phone-a-thon. Over a dozen volunteers have gathered to call and garner gifts, while answering any questions parishioners might have over the next several weeks leading up to Commitment Weekend.

St. Theresa's, Scarborough: Fr. Pabilona and campaign volunteers are happy to announce that during Masses on September 27 & 28, the parish raised over **\$80,000** from Commitment Weekend activities. St. Theresa's will finish its campaign with at least **\$377,080** raised, or **183%** of goal! Congratulations!

St. John Chrysostom, Newmarket: Fr. Ouellette and campaign volunteers launched a concerted effort to follow up on pending requests in preparation for Commitment Weekend. In order to encourage parishioners who have already been visited with to make their pledge, there has been a focus on reminders from the pulpit, campaign updates in the bulletin, and volunteers have put a special effort into making any remaining follow up visits.
