Pilot Parish "Family Snapshots"

Merciful Redeemer, Mississauga: Fr. Vid Vlasic and his team of volunteers started making phone calls this past week to reach out to parishioners in the Special Phase who received materials in the mail regarding the Family of Faith campaign. Five gifts were received, including one gift of **\$7,500**, which was higher than the requested amount of **\$6,000!**

St. Joseph, Mississauga: Last week, Fr. Marc-Andre Campbell was pleased to inform his parishioners that St. Joseph has just crossed over the **\$1 million** mark for pledges received! Fr. Marc-Andre has many exciting plans for his parish share, including improving the sound system currently in the parish.

St. Isaac Jogues, Pickering: Father Dobson and his volunteers received another **7** gifts totalling **\$35,500** bringing the parish to **83%** of its campaign goal. Last week, volunteers were trained in preparation for phone-a-thons when over 1,500 parishioners will be contacted with hopes of high participation.

Precious Blood, Scarborough: The parish received another **8** gifts, bringing the campaign total to over **\$640,000**, or **178%** of its goal. With upcoming phone-a-thons, Father Murphy and the volunteers are excited at the possibility of doubling their campaign goal.



Representatives from all 10 Pilot Parishes gathered on April 7, 2014 to share stories of their success and to provide valuable feedback about the campaign to date. Chris Polito, Executive Director, was there to update everyone on the tremendous results the pilot parishes have achieved.

Guardian Angels, Orillia: Father Andrew Cyruk and volunteers had a very successful first phone-a-thon, raising their campaign total high enough to complete three more maintenance projects! They look forward to the final weeks of the campaign, striving to raise enough funds to put towards the long list of tasks that they are faced with at the parish.

Our Lady of Mount Carmel, Toronto: Father Peter Chin and volunteers are looking forward to the final weeks of the campaign. To date, they have raised **\$171,750**. While continuing visits, they are also preparing for their commitment weekends in the beginning of May.

St. Mary's, Brampton: As Easter approaches, St. Mary's concludes the Advance Phase of their campaign. Fr. Liborio is proud to report that this latest phase has brought in **\$450,000**, just over **50%** of their aggregate goal! This amazing accomplishment could not have been done without the hard work and dedication of campaign volunteers and the parishioners of St. Mary's.

St. Luke's, Thornhill: Father Bill Burns and his volunteers had a great week, raising **\$79,645** surpassing their goal of **\$735,000**. They are eager to continue phone-a-thons and receive back to the parish 75% of all new pledges. Congratulations to St. Luke's for their success to date!
