## Pilot Parish "Family Snapshots"

**St. Andrew Kim, North York:** As the campaign enters its final weeks, activity has not slowed down at St. Andrew Kim. With the recent **39** gifts received and **\$61,000** raised, total gifts now exceed **300** and the parish is **\$450,000** over goal.

**Merciful Redeemer, Mississauga:** Fr. Vid and his volunteers, through two phone-a-thons and follow-up from pending parishioners, received nearly **\$100,000** in pledges this past week.

**St. Ann's, Penetanguishene:** St. Ann's received more than **\$30,000** in new gifts representing an increase of more than **10%**. Pledges have also been received during recent phone-a-thons, which has encouraged the volunteer parish callers to keep calling other parishioners.

**St. Isaac Jogues, Pickering:** As volunteers continue to reach out to other parishioners during phone-a-thons, the parish has reached **90%** of their campaign goal. Father Dobson and the volunteers hope to reach their goal soon in advance of commitment weekend. Then Father can announce that the parish will now receive **75%** of additional funds.

**St. Mary's, Brampton:** As St. Mary's begins its Special Phase and looks forward to an even more successful campaign, a great turnout of 30 people have volunteered and attended the initial orientation and training meeting!

**Our Lady of Mount Carmel, Toronto:** Father Peter Chin had a very successful week, securing a lead gift for **\$100,000!** The parish has currently raised **200%** of their goal, and hopes to continue their success in the upcoming commitment weekends. Congratulations Our Lady of Mount Carmel!

**Guardian Angels, Orillia:** Father Andrew Cyruk and volunteers successfully completed their phone-a-thons with a total of **\$770,000** raised. With **153%** of their goal raised from just 6% of their parish they are excited to complete the campaign with a successful commitment weekend!
