



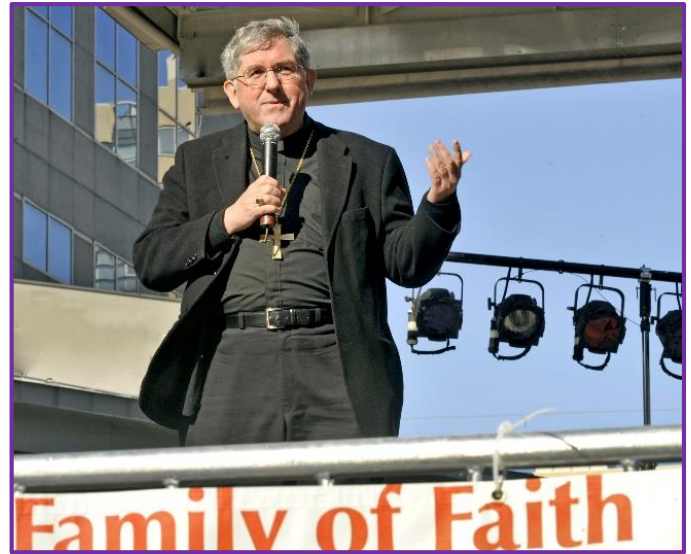
Campaign Progress

In his message to Catholics when the Family of Faith campaign was introduced in the archdiocese, His Eminence, Cardinal Thomas Collins, wrote: “Both our Pastoral Plan and our Family of Faith campaign will help us to be more effective in the mission on which Jesus sends us; to love God and show that love by serving others. As we do that together, our lives will be changed, and we will discover more fully the deep joy of being disciples of Jesus.”

The Pastoral Plan continues to be implemented in the archdiocese and across all 225 parishes. The Family of Faith campaign, so important to the success of the Pastoral Plan is proving to be very successful in the parishes that have thus far participated in the campaign.

The 20 parishes participating in Wave 1 have, to date, received generous donations and pledges totaling over **\$13.8 million**. That’s 139 per cent of their collective goals. As more parishes participate in the campaign, it is clear that parishioners are both very generous with their gifts and supportive of the goals of the campaign.

Overall, the campaign has raised more than **\$45.5 million** or **43 per cent** of the \$105 million minimum goal for the campaign. The almost 70 parishes participating in Wave 2 of the campaign are now in their early stages. Their collective goal is **\$30.0 million**. In the coming weeks, their progress will be shared via Family Update.



Wave 1 Parish “Family Snapshots”

St. Paschal Baylon, Thornhill: Fr. Rosato and volunteers dedicated additional time after the parish’s Commitment Weekend to follow-up with parishioners who made pledges to the campaign. Volunteers enthusiastically called parishioners who were still praying about their participation to answer questions as well as confirm payment information from families who indicated they wanted to make a gift. This additional activity after the active portion of the campaign has garnered St. Paschal Baylon an additional **\$40,000** which helped them exceed **\$2 million** in pledged gifts!

St. Mary Star of the Sea, Mississauga: Fr. Neil McMillan conducted a very successful Commitment Weekend. The parish raised an additional **\$146,810**, a large portion of which will go toward installation of a parish hall sound system and upgrading their parish hall kitchen. The parish has now concluded its campaign at an amazing 151% of goal (**\$620,217** raised on a \$410,000 goal)! Congratulations, St. Mary Star of the Sea!

Our Lady of Fatima Shrine, Scarborough: Over Thanksgiving weekend, this parish was blessed with the generosity of its parishioners who committed an additional **\$154,000** towards the campaign. These gifts helped the parish surpassed their goal of **\$485,000**. A big thanks to the dedicated parish volunteers, Fr. Mallia and his leadership and faith in the campaign plan, and all the generous families who supported the Family in Faith campaign. Congratulations!

St. Maria Goretti, Scarborough: Parishioners have responded tremendously over the past week, raising more than **\$126,000** from personal visits and phone-a-thons! This success is only possible due to the hard work and dedication of the many campaign volunteers and the generous parishioners at St. Maria Goretti.
