



Campaign Progress and News

Wave 2 parishes have now raised over **\$15.1 million**, which is more than half way (57%) to their collective goal. Eleven parishes have exceeded their goals, with others close behind. Overall, the campaign has now raised gifts and pledges of **\$64.3 million** or 61% of the Family of Faith campaign's minimum \$105 million goal.

Wave 2 Tips and Hints

Wave 2 Campaign Highlights

St. Matthew's Parish, Toronto: Father Grecki and his volunteers are working very hard towards the parish's goal. Volunteers are calling to invite all Special Phase donors to join in group meetings, where Father presents the video and case, asking for support. Last week, the Italian and Portuguese versions of the video were screened at parish meetings.

St. Andrew Parish, Etobicoke: Last week, the parish was able to raise **\$58,200**, doubling its total from the previous week to **\$114,350**. The parish is now at 25% of its goal. The campaign is really gaining momentum with the growth in volunteers following the Advance Gift Orientation meeting.

With the combined efforts of these new additions, and those who have continued from the Major Phase, all 144 families in the Advance Phase have been assigned to a volunteer for a visit.
