

Campaign Results to Date

The recent severe weather has not been chilling the spirits of pastors and volunteers who continue to brave the cold and attend meetings and donor visits. Thank you so much for all you do!

Overall, the campaign has now raised gifts and pledges of **\$74.5 million** or **71%** of the Family of Faith campaign's minimum \$105 million goal. Wave 2 parishes have now raised over **\$22.7 million**, which is **85%** of their collective goal. Many of these campaigns have now been broadly announced in their parishes with several already holding their Commitment Weekends.

Wave 3 information sessions are now underway. Last week, Family of Faith Campaign office staff held sessions at St. Barnabas and St. Elizabeth Seton parishes. This week, we are holding sessions at St. Bonaventure Parish and Nativity of our Lord Parish. The meeting format includes a question and answer segment. Pastors and parishioners often ask how financial and personal information is protected. Wave 2 Campaign Highlights

St. Michael's Cathedral, Toronto: Fr. Busch and the entire campaign team are so very proud that the Cathedral has surpassed its goal of **\$1.34 million!** The recently held Commitment Weekend was a huge success and only possible with the hard work and dedication of campaign volunteers. Fr. Busch would like to thank all those who were involved in this accomplishment!

St. Mary of the Angels, Toronto: Father Landorff had a successful orientation meeting on February 14th, for dedicated volunteers who are calling 600 Special Phase donors. Calls are being made in 3 languages: Portuguese, Italian and English.

Our Lady of the Assumption, Toronto: Father Ben and his team are providing more details about the campaign to parishioners and receiving gifts, after over 8,000 parishioners received the pastor letter and parish brochure by mail.

St. Helen's, Toronto: Father Cabral reached his goal after a successful Commitment Weekend on February 14th and 15th. The parish is now at **115%** of this goal.

Our Lady of Guadalupe, Toronto: Parishioners showed their overwhelming support of the Family of Faith campaign over the frigid Valentine's Day weekend. The parish has raised over **\$270,000** on its Commitment Weekend to surpass their target of \$335,000! They have now raised **\$517,160** and are thrilled with their results.

Holy Family, Bolton: Through their last week of phone-a-thons and Commitment Weekend, the parish raised another **\$100,000** in the past week! As parishioners continue to follow up on those still praying about their participation in the Family of Faith campaign, the parish hopes to be over \$800,000 raised by next week. Well done!

St. Anthony of Padua, Brampton: As Fr. Mullins and his team of volunteers have been hard at work continuing to visit with parishioners, decisions from parishioners have continued to come in. They have now raised over **\$450,000** and are looking forward to attempting to achieve goal prior to their Commitment Weekend in March.

Blessed Trinity, Willowdale: Fr. Murphy and volunteers had a very successful Commitment Weekend, raising over \$300,000 towards their \$915,000 goal. Their total now stands at **\$1.6 million**. Their plans include replacement of their boilers and the carpeting in the church.

St. Gregory's, Etobicoke: Fr. Bertao and volunteers are working hard at the Advanced Phase. Volunteers have received numerous pledges in the past week. They are looking forward to welcoming more volunteers to their team at their Special Gift Orientation this week.

Chinese Martyrs, Markham: Fr. Deng and volunteers had a very successful Commitment Weekend, raising over \$160,000. Almost 500 families have participated to raise **\$1.2 million**.

Paroisse Sainte-Famille, Mississauga: Fr. Badr received a **\$25,000** gift, which is the parish's largest gift to date. Fr. Badr and his volunteers have raised over \$115,000 toward their goal of \$140,000.

St. Benedict's, Etobicoke: Fr. Pace welcomed **19** new families to the parish's Major Gift Orientation on February 2, officially kicking off the Major Phase of the parish campaign.

Prince of Peace, Scarborough: Father Imperial and campaign volunteers welcomed families for the Special Phase orientation meeting last Monday. The team will hold another orientation this week in order to ensure that all families who are interested in attending are able to do so.

St. Lawrence Martyr, Scarborough: Father Farrell and volunteers successfully conducted their Commitment Weekend. Despite the inclement weather, the parish raised 20% of its goal. The parish was over goal previous to the weekend, and will look forward to receiving over-goal funds.
