



## Campaign Results to Date

Wave 2 parishes have now raised over **\$26.8 million**, which is **97%** of their collective goal. 24 parishes have surpassed their goals. Many Commitment Weekends will take place in March. The three parishes running active Combined Campaigns have raised **\$7.8 million** and achieved 91% of their collective goal. Overall, the campaign has now raised gifts and pledges of **\$78.5 million** or **75%** of the Family of Faith campaign's minimum \$105 million goal.

**St. Catherine of Siena**, Mississauga: Publicizing the campaign in the parish is starting to pay off! This past week, St. Catherine of Siena received **34** gifts for **\$87,212**. Phone-a-thon volunteers are seeing the results of their labours. The parish has now raised **66%** of its goal looks forward to a successful Commitment Weekend on March 14 and 15.

**St. Roch's**, Weston: Volunteers at St. Roch's have put special effort into crafting a campaign booth in the church, complete with information about the archdiocesan case and parish case elements, the campaign prayer, pledge forms, and a special display tracking the parish's campaign progress. **Saint Louis de France**, North York: With the parish well past its goal of \$110,000 (it has raised **\$140,000** or 127% of its goal), Fr. Ziad and the Campaign Executive Committee are looking forward to closing out the campaign with Commitment Weekend on March 14 and 15.

**St. Philip Neri**, North York: Over the past week, the parish surpassed 50% of its goal. They have raised **\$332,855**. Father Duplessie and volunteers are looking forward to Commitment Weekend this upcoming month.



At St. Philip Neri Church, the solid oak pews have become worn over time. The parish will refinish the pews to provide a comfortable environment in which all parishioners can worship.

**Our Lady of the Miraculous Medal**, Etobicoke: Fr. Batic welcomed 14 more parishioners to the Orientation Meeting. They also raised over **\$60,000**, or 20% of their goal in just one week.

**Holy Spirit**, Agincourt: The campaign at Holy Spirit parish is set to come to a successful close. This week, the parish reached the 95% mark, achieving \$431,563 on a \$455,000 goal. Father Moore and volunteers fully expect to have a rewarding Commitment Weekend!
