



Wave 2 Parishes at 109% of Goal!

Wave 2 parishes have now raised over **\$29.2 million**, which is **109%** of their collective goal. More than half these parishes— 30, have surpassed their goals. Commitment Weekends are proving to be highly effective for the parishes. The three parishes running active Combined Campaigns have raised **\$7.8 million** and achieved **92%** of their collective goal.

Overall, the campaign has now raised gifts and pledges of **\$81.75 million** or **78%** of the Family of Faith campaign's minimum \$105 million goal.

Important Information for Wave 3 Parishes

Wave 3 campaigns will begin in April. Over the past couple of months, the Family of Faith campaign office has been working with pastors to help assist in the preparations necessary to run a successful campaign. Here are some important reminders for Wave 3 pastors:

1. Pastors will be informed of the name of their Parish Campaign Director in late March or April
2. The director will then arrange the first one-to-one meeting with the pastor
3. Volunteers are integral to each parish campaign. Pastors are encouraged to consider who they believe will be effective volunteers when it comes to parishioner-to-parishioner fundraising
4. However, pastors should not formally invite volunteer participation or form committees without first consulting their director
5. Remember that the parish campaigns are phased in over a twenty week period. The broad parish-wide invitation to participate in the campaign won't occur until at least the half-way mark
6. Pastors should not be approaching prospective donors before they are trained by their director
7. The campaign office is working diligently to produce brochures for each parish campaign. Timely provision of your requested materials will help expedite production
