



Another Record Week!

Last week, Wave 2 parishes raised just over **\$5 million** in gifts and pledges, largely due to the great success of the Commitment Weekends held in many parishes. Wave 2 parishes have now raised over **\$34 million**, which is **128%** of their collective goal. 38 parishes have surpassed their goals. The three parishes running active Combined Campaigns have raised **\$8.1 million** and achieved **95%** of their collective goal.

Overall, the campaign has now raised gifts and pledges of **\$86.97 million** or **83%** of the Family of Faith campaign's minimum \$105 million goal.

Wave 2 News

Our Lady of the Miraculous Medal, Etobicoke: Fr. Batic had a great Commitment Weekend. His parish raised over \$300,000 in a single weekend, going over its \$360,000 goal. The parish has raised **\$419,000**.

Our Lady Help of Christians, Toronto: Fr. Batic was excited to raise over \$60,000 at the parish's Commitment Weekend. They now have **\$89,000** raised towards their \$115,000 goal.

St. Gregory's, Etobicoke: Fr. Bertao and volunteers were extremely happy to have raised over \$200,000 last week from their Special Phase phone calls and their Commitment Weekend. They now have a total of \$830,000 raised—**152%** of their goal!

St. Paul the Apostle, Alliston: On the eve of their Commitment Weekend, St. Paul the Apostle parish surpassed its goal of \$385,000! Fr. Glass and campaign volunteers are really excited at the prospect of realizing their full potential over the next couple weeks.

Prince of Peace, Scarborough: Father Imperial and campaign volunteers conducted an extremely successful Commitment Weekend. The Campaign Executive Committee ensured there were captains for each Commitment Weekend Mass, and were well prepared ahead of time. Due in large part to these impeccable organizational capabilities and the wonderful remarks by Father Imperial, the parish raised \$575,000 or 69% of its goal in just one week! The parish has raised **\$1.12 million** to date or 142% of its goal.

St. Dunstan's, Scarborough: Father Masterson is pleased with his parish campaign's progress. Due to the generosity of its parishioners, St. Dunstan's reached over **200%** of its \$245,000 goal this week. The funding will help ensure much needed capital work in the church.

St. Patrick's, Markham: Fr. Barber was amazed at the outcome from his Commitment Weekend. St. Patrick's raised over \$1 million during the week from over 400 new gifts. Their parish has now raised nearly **\$2.5 million**. Congrats to Fr. Barber and everyone at St. Patrick's!

St. Anthony of Padua, Brampton: At its Commitment Weekend, Fr. Mullins and volunteers secured gifts in excess of **\$350,000!** Volunteers have already started following up with parishioners who are still reflecting on their decision, in an effort to try to get to \$1 million raised overall.

St. Louis de France, North York: Fr. Ziad and the Campaign Executive Committee raised over \$70,000 on Commitment Weekend, bringing the parish total to **\$211,490** which is over **\$100,000** over goal!

Holy Angels, Etobicoke: Fr. Gioppato, Fr. Wilk, and the Family of Faith volunteers have raised over **\$200,000** in two weeks! The parish looks forward to concluding its campaign activity next week.

Croatian Martyrs, Mississauga: Fr. Ivica and Fr. Tomislav have raised over **\$100,000** toward the parish's goal and look forward to celebrating a very successful Commitment Weekend.

Saint Catherine of Siena, Mississauga: After a successful Commitment Weekend, St. Catherine of Siena raised **\$368,860** and surpassed its goal of \$670,000! Father Lando and volunteers worked very hard to achieve their goal. All the hard work pays off!

St. Jane Frances, North York: Father Nardone and volunteers conducted a fantastic Commitment Weekend raising **\$178,790**. They have now raised **\$524,730** on their goal of \$490,000. Their success in the campaign is a true testament of having faith in the plan.

Our Lady of the Assumption, Toronto: The parish raised **\$465,000** in the commitment weekend, 72% of its goal. Thanks to a dedicated group of volunteers led by Jose Bona and the inspirational remarks of Father Ben about the campaign.

Our Lady of Fatima, Brampton: Father Chilmon organized a recognition lunch for volunteers, featuring traditional Portuguese cuisine. The group celebrated their successful campaign, reaching **126%** of the parish goal.
