## Almost \$90 million!

Parishioner response to the Family of Faith campaign continues to be very strong. Wave 2 parishes have now raised over **\$36.5 million**, which is **136%** of their collective goal. 44 parishes have surpassed their goals. The three parishes running active Combined Campaigns have raised **\$8.1 million** and achieved **97%** of their collective goal.

Overall, the campaign has now raised gifts and pledges of **\$89.4 million** or **85%** of the Family of Faith campaign's minimum \$105 million goal.

The great success we've seen throughout March is largely due to the effectiveness of the Commitment Weekends that were held in most Wave 2 parishes this month. The campaign thanks the pastors and hundreds of volunteers who helped present the campaign to their parishioners during the Commitment Weekends.

**Parish Sharing Formula Explained**

Twenty-five parishes have volunteered to help us this campaign. They have agreed to share 25% of their parishioner's gifts and pledges with the campaign. The remaining 75% will go to the Archdiocese of Toronto. This means that for every \$100 of gifts and pledges, \$25 goes to the campaign and \$75 goes to the Archdiocese. This is a great way to support the campaign and the Archdiocese.

## Wave 2 News

**St. David's, Maple:** The parish has surpassed its goal, raising donations and pledges of \$1,083,825 to date! This follows a very successful Commitment Weekend, where **\$401,170** was raised in one week. This was only made possible through the hard work and dedication of campaign volunteers. Fr. De Ciccio would like to thank all those involved for helping to make the campaign for St. David's such a success.

**St. Philip Neri, North York:** Father Duplessie and volunteers are thrilled to announce that they have surpassed their goal of \$625,000 after Commitment Weekend. Father is very pleased with the results of the campaign. The parish has now raised **\$643,466**.

**St. Timothy, Orangeville:** Fr. Sean and volunteers remain hard at work, as they are counting down their final weeks of the campaign, which will wrap up in late April. Fr. Sean is still receiving major gifts of \$25,000!

**All Saints, Etobicoke:** Congratulations to the parishioners as they have gone beyond their goal and raised nearly **\$800,000** on a goal of \$730,000! Their recent Commitment Weekend was a success raising \$157,600, or more than 20% of their goal.

**Good Shepherd, Thornhill:** Fr. Iacobelli and volunteers are pleased that during their Commitment Weekend, they raised more than **\$250,000**, propelling them over goal! They perfectly executed the plan for Commitment Weekend and it showed. Congratulations!

**Croatian Martyrs, Mississauga:** The parish raised over **\$140,000** on Commitment Weekend! Fr. Tomislav and Fr. Ivica continue to follow up on campaign requests and look forward to concluding the parish's activity in April.

**St. Benedict, Etobicoke:** The parish celebrated the campaign's public announcement in masses last weekend. Fr. Pace and the Family of Faith campaign volunteers have raised almost \$150,000 toward the parish's goal.

**Sacred Heart, King City:** Having raised 37% of their goal, or \$112,100, in the past week alone, Sacred Heart parish has reached and surpassed their goal of \$300,000! Congratulations to Fr. Michael and campaign volunteers on this marvelous achievement!

**Holy Name, Toronto:** As their parish's Family of Faith campaign comes to an end, the parish has raised over **\$704,000** on a goal of \$235,000, or 276% of goal! This includes the recent Commitment Weekend that raised over \$100,000. This was a great effort from Fr. Morasse and campaign volunteers which made it all possible.

**St. John Vianney, Barrie:** The combined campaign parish made its public announcement this past weekend to much enthusiasm. The parish has raised \$960,000 towards their \$1.5 million goal including three leadership gifts of \$100,000.
