



Campaign Update

Overall, the campaign has raised more than **\$48.1 million** or **46 per cent** of the \$105 million minimum goal for the campaign. The 20 parishes participating in Wave 1 have, to date, received generous donations and pledges totaling **\$14.5 million**. That's **145 per cent** of their collective goals.

News You Can Use

- With the calendar year coming to a close, many prospective donors may want the benefit of a 2014 tax receipt. When meeting with parishioners, keep this in mind so that donors can benefit from charitable tax receipts issued for Family of Faith campaign donations. Note that only the portion paid in the tax year may be received. For example, a 5 year pledge of \$10,000, paid in \$2,000 annual installments, with a first payment this year, would receive a tax receipt for \$2,000 for 2014.
- Did you know that many employers will match the charitable contributions of employees? These “Matching Gift” programs can increase the value of a gift from parishioners. Each employer’s program is different. Every prospective donor will receive a copy of our brochure: “Increase the Impact of Your Gift” when they are invited to participate in the Family of Faith Campaign. - In response to prospective donors who wish to consider making a gift to the Family of Faith campaign in their will, we have produced a “Planned Giving” brochure. Providing for the campaign in a last will and testament can be a wonderful legacy to leave in support of the Family of Faith campaign.

Parish Highlights

This week brought the terrific news of another **Wave 1** parish exceeding its goal. **St. Maria Goretti**, Scarborough, parish enjoyed a very successful Commitment Weekend on October 25 and 26. That weekend, parishioners pledged 49 per cent of the parish goal. As of this report, the parish has a total of **\$790,170**, or 132 per cent of goal. Congratulations to Father Galea and his generous parish family!

At this stage of the campaign, many **Wave 2** parishes are holding their first Campaign Executive Committee (CEC) meetings. At **Prince of Peace**, Scarborough 15 families attended its recent CEC orientation. Father Imperial is looking forward to this week’s meeting when he expects to close some gifts and get all Committee positions filled. **Our Lady of Guadalupe**, Toronto held its CEC orientation and had 11 people in attendance. They are very excited to get started with the campaign. **St. Philip Neri**, North York, **St. Catherine of Siena**, Mississauga, **St. Anthony of Padua**, Brampton, **St. John the Evangelist** and **St. Cornelius**, Caledon also held their CEC orientations and reported very good attendance.

Several **Wave 2** parishes are also beginning to receive leadership gifts as they begin their campaigns. **St. Patrick's**, Markham received 8 gifts for nearly **\$250,000**. **Holy Name**, Toronto, received a \$50,000 donation from a CEC member last week, a big step toward their \$255,000 goal.
