



Half Way to \$105 Million!

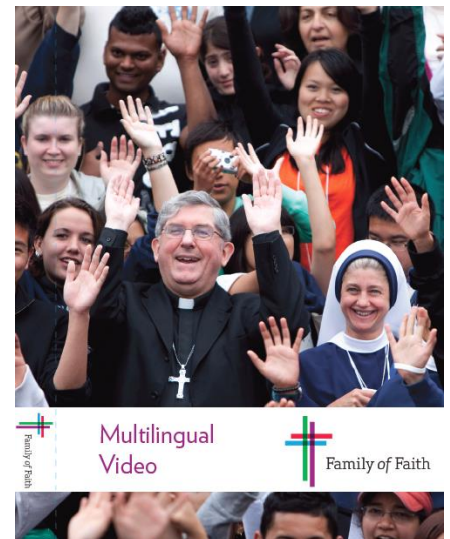
Overall, the campaign has raised gifts and pledges of **\$53.9 million** or **51 per cent** of the \$105 million minimum goal for the campaign. Wave 2 parishes have now raised 22% of their collective goal.

This is a tremendous achievement since less than half of the parishes in the archdiocese have completed their campaigns or have campaigns underway. Congratulations to the clergy, volunteers and parishioners from across the archdiocese who are working so hard to ensure the goals of the Family of Faith campaign can be achieved.

News You Can Use

Year-end tax planning: Debit and credit card gifts to the Family of Faith campaign are processed on the first day of each month. With the calendar year coming to a close, many new donors may want the benefit of a 2014 tax receipt. When meeting with parishioners from now until the end of December, keep this in mind so that donors can benefit from a 2014 charitable tax receipt. If requested by the donor, a credit or debit payment can be processed on December 31st with the next monthly payment scheduled for February 1, 2015.

Wave 2 Parish Highlights

Holy Name, Toronto: Fr. Morasse received just under \$100,000 in commitments over the past week from only 7 gifts! Holy Name Parish is off to a great start with **\$146,600** already raised towards its goal of \$255,000.

St. Mary of the Angels Parish, Toronto: Fr. Landorff is achieving great results and is now at **52%** of his goal. The parish is celebrating its 100th year anniversary on January 1st, 2015 and this success is a great way to help celebrate it.

St. Columbkille, Orillia: Fr. Cyruk and parish volunteers were excited to exceed their goal. **\$87,080** has been raised against a goal of \$85,000. They're looking forward to their Commitment Weekend next weekend, on December 13 and 14.

St. Francis of Assisi, Orillia: **\$53,520** has been raised, exceeding the parish's \$50,000 goal. Fr. Cyruk says he looks forward to the parish's Commitment Weekend next weekend, on December 13 and 14.

Blessed Trinity, Willowdale: Fr. Murphy and volunteers had a successful week—raising **\$139,040**. They look forward to a successful turnout for their Advance Gift Orientation meeting with parishioners this week.

Chinese Martyrs Catholic Church, Markham: Fr. Deng and volunteers have been very successful— raising **\$101,000** in a single week.

St. John the Evangelist and St. Cornelius, Caledon East: The parish raised **\$40,000** in new gifts, getting them to 20% of their goal, as volunteers begin to visit with fellow parishioners and share information about the campaign.

St. Anthony of Padua, Brampton: Volunteers are eager to begin making visits and continue to spread the message of the Family of Faith campaign, the same way Fr. Mullins has been doing the last few weeks.

Combined Campaigns

Combined campaigns are run in parishes with extraordinary needs that require a fundraising effort beyond the regular Family of Faith parish campaign. The vast majority of campaigns have goals set at 130% of the parish's total annual offertory. A combined campaign typically has a fundraising goal that is anywhere between three and five times the parish's annual offertory. These campaigns require resources beyond those assigned to a 'standard' campaign. Combined campaigns employ dedicated staff and are conducted over a longer period of time—usually six months.
