



Campaign Progress and News

Overall, the campaign has now raised gifts and pledges of **\$55.8 million** or **53 per cent** of the \$105 million minimum goal for the Family of Faith campaign. Wave 2 parishes have raised 27% of their collective goal. Three of these have already reached and surpassed their goals.

This is a tremendous achievement since less than half of the parishes in the archdiocese have completed their campaigns or have campaigns underway. Congratulations to the clergy, volunteers and parishioners from across the archdiocese who are working so hard to ensure the goals of the Family of Faith campaign can be achieved.

Year-end tax planning: Debit and credit card gifts to the Family of Faith campaign are processed on the first day of each month. With the calendar year coming to a close, many new donors may want the benefit of a 2014 tax receipt. When meeting with parishioners from now until the end of December, keep this in mind so that donors can benefit from a 2014 charitable tax receipt. If requested by the donor, a credit or debit payment can be processed on December 31st with the next monthly payment scheduled for February 1, 2015.

Campaign Highlights

St. Patrick's, Markham: Volunteers have started making visits and Fr. Barber has been working hard at closing pending decisions. This collaborative effort helped raise over **\$100,000** in new pledges last week.

St. John Fisher, Bramalea: Fr. Grima has begun to meet with parishioners to solicit and recruit his Campaign Executive Committee.

St. Dunstan's, Scarborough: The parish has received **\$140,400** from 10 gifts, raising 57% of its goal in a single week.

St. Lawrence Martyr, Scarborough: The parish raised **\$32,720** this week, bringing the parish to 47% of goal. The parish has only just begun the Advance Phase of the campaign.

Chinese Martyrs Catholic Parish, Markham: Last week, Fr. Deng and volunteers were very excited to have raised \$112,000 in just one week. They now have a total of \$496,850 raised towards their \$730,000 goal. They have their public announcement on December 13 and 14."

St. Columbkille, Uptergrove: Fr. Cyruk and volunteers have their Commitment Weekend on December 13 and 14. They are looking forward to receiving the results.

St. Francis, Washago: Fr. Cyruk and volunteers have their Commitment Weekend on December 13 and 14.

Blessed Trinity, Willowdale: Fr. Murphy had a successful Advance Gift Orientation with over 75 families attending. They hope to expand their team of volunteers as they engage more parish families in the campaign.

St. Agnes Kouying Tsao, Markham: Fr. Chong was excited to have raised over **\$100,000** last week, which places the parish at 97% of its \$490,000 goal.

Lithuanian Martyrs Parish, Mississauga: This past week eclipsed the **\$100,000** mark. All volunteers and Father Vytas are very excited to continued success of the campaign.

St. Justin, Martyr, Unionville: \$557,800 has been raised, including **\$100,500** that was raised this past week. The volunteers are hard at work visiting as many parishioners as possible before Christmas.

St. Catherine of Siena, Mississauga: The parish raised a total of **\$113,000**. The volunteers have been working extremely hard to see everyone in the Major Phase before Christmas.

Our Lady of Perpetual Help, Toronto (combined campaign): Father Hannah reports: “Our campaign continues to move along well. We have close to forty trained parish ambassadors who have been out connecting with parishioners. They are providing them with information about both the archdiocesan as well as our own parish campaign and leaving a package of material with them to ensure an informed decision regarding their support is made in a timely manner. Parishioners have been very responsive and supportive and for that I am most grateful.”
