Campaign Progress and News

The close of the calendar year is a good time to reflect back on the many successes of the Family of Faith campaign in 2014. The ten parishes in the Pilot Phase of the campaign raised **\$12.1 million**—166% of their collective goal. Wave 1 parishes were also very successful, raising **\$15.1 million**—152% of their aggregate goal. Wave 2 parishes have thus far raised **34%** of their collective goal. Leadership Phase gifts total **\$18.3 million** from 28 gifts. Overall, the campaign has raised an astounding **\$58.2 million**.

Funds raised are already being invested in various projects across the archdiocese. The campaign is directing **\$1.5 million** to Project Connect, an ambitious effort to improve web technology and infrastructure. With \$200,000 being invested now, all parish websites will move towards a common platform with improved connectivity among parishes and new features to keep Catholics informed of what's happening in their *family of faith*.

Ryerson University chaplaincy also received a boost from the Family of Faith campaign. The Ryerson chaplaincy (one of seven campus chaplaincies operated at post-secondary institutions in the GTA) had an urgent need for improved space to house its outreach centre. To address this need, **\$1 million** was invested to upgrade Hogan House, an archdiocesan building near the campus.

The Family of Faith campaign earmarked \$20 million for loans to help parish communities accelerate church construction. With funds from the Family of Faith campaign, the archdiocese committed to a loan of **\$2 million** to Guardian Angels parish in Brampton to build their hall, the first phase of their new church construction.

2014 tax receipts: Debit and credit card gifts to the Family of Faith campaign are processed on the first day of each month. With the calendar year coming to a close, many new donors may want the benefit of a 2014 tax receipt. If requested by the donor, a credit or debit payment can be processed on December 31st with the next monthly payment scheduled for February 1, 2015.



Precious Blood Parish in Scarborough participated in the Pilot Phase of the campaign. It raised over \$800,000 in gifts and pledges—or 223% of its goal.

Wave 2 Highlights

All Saints, Etobicoke: Fr. Glaba continues his visits and parishioners are responding warmly to the needs of the parish and archdiocese. Over the past week parishioners have committed **\$72,000**.

St. Paul the Apostle, Alliston: Fr. Glass has received a **\$100,000** commitment to the campaign at St. Paul the Apostle! The parish is now at 33% of its goal and looks forward to more success in 2015.

St. Catherine of Siena, Mississauga: The parish raised **\$46,000** this week and has now exceeded \$150,000 in total gifts and pledges. Everyone is very excited about progress and looks forward to continued success in the Advance Phase.

St. Justin, Martyr, Unionville: Reached **66%** this week by raising another **\$64,500**. Volunteers and Father Singh are looking forward to beginning their Advance Phase come the beginning on January.



At St. Paul the Apostle, in Alliston, the parish plans to redesign its church courtyard to meet new standards for accessibility, repave its parking areas and repair catch basins.

St. Michael's Cathedral, Toronto: St. Michael's Cathedral publicly launched its parish campaign a few weeks ago and has now surpassed \$1 million raised towards its goal of \$1.34 million. This was only possible thanks to the fantastic and dedicated volunteers who have committed themselves to the campaign.

St. Patrick's, Markham: Fr. Barber and his volunteers have continued to close pending decisions, receiving nearly another **\$100,000** in gifts this past week and surpassing \$500,000 raised!

St. John Fisher, Bramalea: Fr. Grima received his first gifts to the campaign this week and in just one week was able to secure 15% of his goal in gifts!

Church of the Good Shepherd, Thornhill: Fr. Iacobelli and volunteers will visit with Major Phase parishioners through the New Year to continue building early momentum before starting the Advance Phase.



At the Church of the Good Shepherd in Thornhill, their plans include the purchase of a new permanent altar and matching complement the design of the church.
