



Campaign Progress and News

The Family of Faith campaign begins 2015 with excellent news regarding the progress of the campaign. Wave 2 parishes have now achieved 43 per cent of their collective goal with 8 parishes exceeding their goals. Overall, the campaign has received donations and pledges of **\$61 million** or 58 per cent of the minimum \$105 million goal.

The Leadership Phase of the campaign has now received **\$18.3 million** from 31 donors.

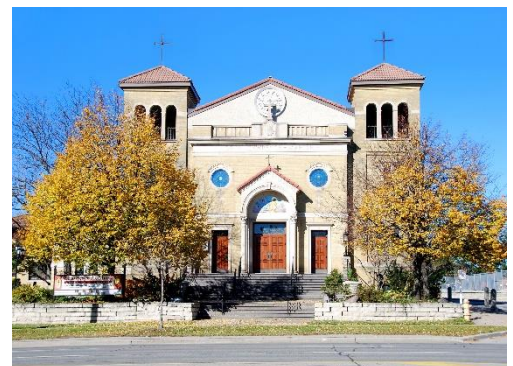
Wave 2 Highlights

Blessed Sacrament, Toronto: Father Marcille and parish volunteers worked diligently in November and December to get the parish campaign running in full swing. Over the holidays, the parish more than doubled its total raised, jumping to **\$467,504** raised, which is 49% of goal from 17 gifts.

Chinese Martyrs, Markham: The parish went over goal with a total of **\$785,000** raised towards their \$730,000 goal.

St. Justin, Martyr, Unionville: Recently, St. Justin, Martyr surpassed 80% of their goal by raising \$145,600 the last two weeks. They have now raised **\$767,900** on their goal of \$945,000. The committee and Father Joe are very excited to begin their Advance Phase Orientations.

St. Lawrence Martyr, Scarborough: Advance Gift Committee members at St. Lawrence Martyr maintained a healthy amount of campaign activity over the holidays. They worked both to schedule and complete visits, with a focus on scheduling visits with parishioners before or after Mass.

St. Agnes Kouying Tsao, Markham: Fr. Frances is excited that his parish has exceeded its \$490,000 goal, and has raised almost **\$940,000**.

St. Patrick's, Markham: Fr. Barber and volunteers ended 2014 strongly, raising another \$100,000 since the last Family Update. They are gearing up to begin their Advance Phase this week.

Sts. Peter and Paul, Mississauga: The parish exceeded its \$850,000 goal and has now raised **\$872,000**.

St. Anthony of Padua, Brampton: The Advance Phase of the campaign is just starting. Fr. Mullins and volunteers have continued to reach out to parishioners and are now closing in at half of their goal of \$620,000!

St. Cecilia's, Toronto: The parish exceeded its \$155,000 goal by raising **\$180,000** to date.

St. Timothy, Orangeville: Fr. Sean has begun to meet with parishioners and form his Campaign Executive Committee and even got his first gift to the campaign from a CEC member last week!

Lithuanian Martyrs, Mississauga: Father Vytas and volunteers are proud to announce that they have surpassed **50%**. Last weekend, they had their public announcement stating they have raised **\$143,210** or

55% of their goal. Everyone is very excited to continue their successes.

Our Lady of Guadalupe, Toronto: During the past two weeks, Our Lady of Guadalupe Parish eclipsed **\$200,000** by raising **\$71,300**. They are now at 61% of their goal. Father Miguel and volunteers are looking forward to completing the Advance Phase in January.

St. Vincent de Paul, Toronto: Fr. Utrecht had a very successful Special Gift Orientation last week. He and volunteers are looking forward to beginning the Special Phase to wrap up their campaign.
