



Campaign Progress

The Family of Faith campaign team welcomes the 68 Wave 3 parishes to Family Update, our weekly overview of campaign progress. This week we are launching Volume 3 of Family Update. We'll also continue to share periodic highlights about Wave 2 parish campaigns and encourage everyone to stay up to date by visiting ourFamilyofFaith.ca

This week's Family Update reports on the progress of the 34 Wave 3 parishes that have reported funds raised as of last Friday, May 22nd. Next week, we'll share a list of all parishes that are participating in Wave 3.

Overall, the campaign has raised gifts and pledges of **\$95.5 million** or **91%** of the Family of Faith campaign's goal. The four parishes running active Combined Campaigns have raised **\$9.6 million** and achieved **96%** of their collective goal. Wave 2 parishes have raised over **\$40.1 million**, which is **150%** of their collective goal. 49 of the 58 Wave 2 parishes have exceeded their parish goal.

Wave 3 Parishes

Parish Campaign Directors have now met with all Wave 3 campaign pastors. Most parishes got off to quick start with many volunteer Campaign Executive Committees now formed. Many pastors have also received very positive responses to their gift requests.

Important: Pastors are reminded that details regarding their parish campaigns should be shared with parishioners according to the campaign plan. The Publicity Manual issued to each parish provides strategically timed announcements.

Combined Campaigns

In response to questions from readers, we are pleased to explain Combined Campaigns.

Some parishes have extraordinary fundraising needs and have the capacity to raise far more than their standard Family of Faith goal. Typically, such parishes want to raise three, four-- even five times their annual offertory in a major capital campaign. To be successful, these campaigns require additional professional fundraising counsel at a cost borne by the parish.

The sharing formula for Combined Campaigns is different from a standard Family of Faith campaign. In a standard campaign, the parish receives 25% of funds raised up to its goal and 75% of funds raised thereafter. In a Combined Campaign, the parish must guarantee its archdiocesan contribution and its share of campaign costs. In a Combined Campaign, the proceeds are shared as follows: The archdiocese will receive funds up to a parish's share (75%) of the standard goal and the parish will receive the balance of funds (25%) up to its standard goal and all remaining funds up to its established Combined Campaign goal. Wave 3 Campaign Updates

St. Margaret Mary, Woodbridge: Fr. Grayda held his Campaign Executive Committee (CEC) orientation last week and volunteers are eager to begin meeting with other parishioners. Father Grayda has been meeting with many parishioners to start the campaign and has raised more than \$100,000 in just one week!

Saviour of the World, Mississauga: Fr. Lung and his CEC convened last week for the first time and in the weeks again will begin meeting with parishioners to begin spreading the word about Family of Faith.

St. Rose of Lima, Scarborough: Father Claudio and his CEC members had a very positive Major Gift Orientation with 17 families in attendance. The committee believes this meeting will lead to recruiting more volunteers for the campaign along with hitting their first financial benchmark.

St. John the Evangelist, Whitby: Father Ali is off to a fantastic start. Despite his busy schedule, Father has managed to meet with 9 families and schedule 6 appointments for this week. The reactions have been extremely positive to begin the campaign!

Nativity of Our Lord, Etobicoke: Father Machacek conducted his first CEC meeting on Wednesday May 20th. The 11 families in attendance were positive and supportive of Father's prayerful request to share their time, talent and treasure. They are looking forward to carrying out a successful campaign.

St. Pius X, Toronto: Father Park met with four members of his CEC on Tuesday May 19th, in preparation for their Advance Phase Orientation session this week. Several members of the CEC will share their personal reflections on the campaign.

St. Joseph the Worker Parish, Thornhill: Fr. Salvadori hit the ground running and has gotten the Family of Faith Campaign quickly up to speed in his parish, raising more than \$114,000 or 20% of the parish goal. Hat's off to Fr. Mario for his hard work and the dedicated staff and volunteers of the parish.

St. Norbert's Parish, Toronto: Fr. Beraki has enthusiastically embraced the campaign and has worked quietly and effectively to assemble his Campaign Executive Committee. Through the personal efforts of Fr. Paolos, he has already raised more 25% of the parish's campaign goal of \$185,000. Many thanks to the generosity of parishioners of St. Norbert's parish.
