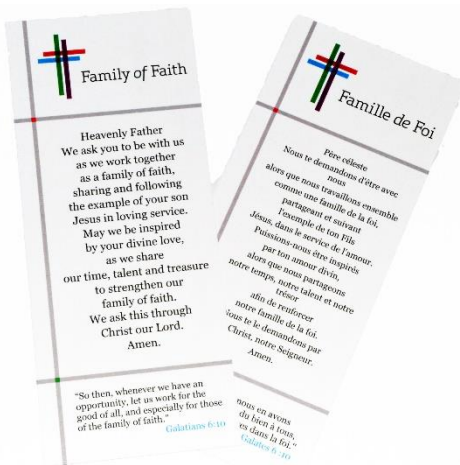




## Campaign Progress

Overall, the campaign has raised gifts and pledges totalling **\$107.85 million**. Wave 3 parishes have raised **\$12.2 million**. Congratulations to all of the Wave 3 parishes that are working so hard and have now achieved **52%** of their collective goal! The four Combined Campaigns have collectively raised almost \$10 million or **107%** of their goal. Our Lady of Lourdes Parish (Combined Campaign) recently surpassed **\$1 million** towards its \$1.5 million goal.

## Wave 3 Reminders



Vacations and summer schedules can make it difficult to connect with parishioners. Most parishes don't have regular church bulletins in the summer months. The campaign's publicity manual (provided to all pastors and campaign chairs and secretaries) contains weekly bulletin inserts and pulpit announcements. Regardless of whether your parish is currently publishing a bulletin, our one page updates (templates found in the campaign Publicity Manual) are an excellent tool to keep parishioners informed.

The Family of Faith campaign is a prayerful exercise and it's important to reinforce this whenever information is shared about the campaign with parishioners. Pastors are encouraged to incorporate the Family of Faith prayer as part of their Sunday liturgies. The weekly readings can also provide 'teachable moments' in Christian stewardship in homilies.

Another excellent way to help keep the campaign fresh in the minds of parishioners is set up a Family of Faith table at the back of the church staffed by members of the Campaign Executive Committee (CEC). Many parishes have found this approach to be highly effective in maintaining contact with prospective donors.

Pastors and campaign volunteers are also reminded of the importance of timely follow-up (within 7 to 10 days) of a gift request. While prospective donors need some time to reflect on their gift, waiting too long to follow-up does not communicate the importance of the request.

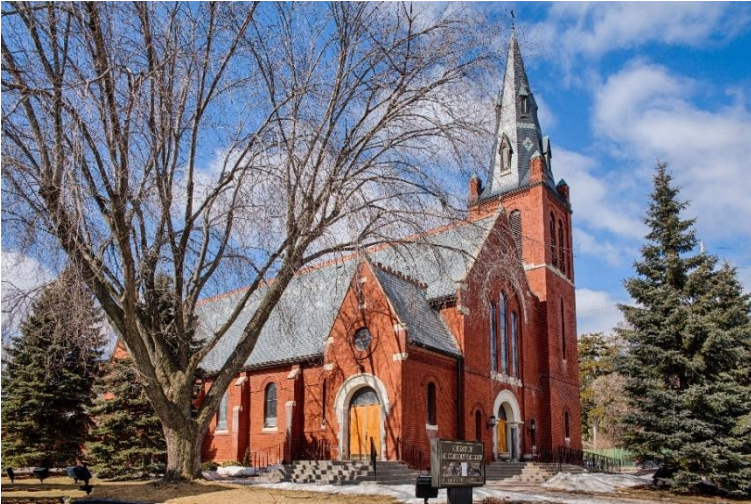

## Wave 4 Parishes

Thank you to all of the clergy and parish representatives who attended our recent information sessions for Wave 4 parishes. Campaign Executive Committee (CEC) members will be the 'backbone' of your parish campaign. Many pastors are already giving much thought to membership on their committee. That's great news. However, pastors are asked to await assigning roles until they have had discussions with their Parish Campaign Directors. All Wave 4 pastors will be contacted by mid-August.

## Wave 3 Updates

**Our Lady Queen of Poland Parish**, Scarborough: Fr. Bobola and the campaign committee are pleased to see that more than 10% of their goal has been raised in the past week. The hard work to meet with parishioners is showing success as families are warmly receptive to the campaign needs.



**St. Gregory the Great Parish**, Oshawa: Volunteers and Fr. O'Brien are thrilled that they received \$70,135, which is 17% of their goal in one week. Additionally, they have been able to recruit 12 more volunteers to help make phone calls. What a successful week!

than \$58,000 was reported this week to boost the campaign over goal! Fr. Joyson George, and his campaign team have received \$492,332 from 102 parishioner commitments exceeding the \$445,000 goal.

**St. Joseph the Worker Parish**, Thornhill: 48 parishioners recently attended the Special Phase orientation meeting to hear more about the Family of Faith campaign. The great turnout is a sign of the strength of this parish community's support of the campaign, which to date has raised over 90% of its parish goal. Congratulations to Fr. Salvadori and to the parish community!

**St. Jerome's Parish**, Brampton: During their first phone-a-thon, 25 volunteers came to help make phone calls to continue spreading the message of Family of Faith. This was a fantastic turnout and volunteers are eager to complete all their calls over the next few weeks leading up to their Commitment Weekend.

**Holy Cross Parish**, Toronto: With the Commitment Weekend, the parish has entered the final leg of its campaign. While the parish had already surpassed its parish goal of \$190,000, an additional \$37,000 was pledged by parishioners during the Commitment Weekend. Congratulations to Fr. Azares and the entire parish!

**Sacred Heart**, Port McNicoll: The parish had a successful Commitment Weekend pushing their parish over goal by raising \$31,150!

**St. Elizabeth Seton Parish**, Newmarket: Volunteers and Fr. Roberts are pleased that they have raised over **33,000** from 13 gifts. All the phone calls are really starting to help drive activity in the campaign. Volunteers are doing a great job of answering parishioners questions after Masses. This has really sparked an increase in giving.

**Nativity of Our Lord Parish**, Etobicoke: Fr. Machacek is pleased to report his parish has raised \$531,966 in gifts and pledges from 82 donors and surpassed their \$495,000 goal. The parish campaign team is completing the Major and Advance phases before moving on to the Special phase and Commitment Weekend.
