



Campaign Progress

Overall, the campaign has raised gifts and pledges totalling **\$108.85 million**. Wave 3 parishes had another excellent week, raising more than \$1 million for a new total of **\$13.2 million**. More than half of our Wave 3 parishes have now achieved at least 60% of their goals. Congratulations to all of the Wave 3 parishes that are working so hard during the summer months and have now achieved **56%** of their collective goal!

Wave 3 Tips

Here are some tips to help pastors and Campaign Executive Committee members continue to be successful and sustain parish interest and involvement:

- ✓ Say the Family of Faith prayer, together, during each Mass;
- ✓ Display a Family of Faith banner in a prominent place (inside or outside);
- ✓ Move your Family of Faith posters to different locations periodically;
- ✓ Include the success of your parish's Family of Faith campaign in the Prayers of the Faithful;
- ✓ Link the goals and objectives of the Family of Faith campaign to the readings, during homilies;
- ✓ Ensure copies of the Archdiocese of Toronto's Pastoral Plan summary are visibly displayed;
- ✓ If you have additional copies of your parish's Family of Faith brochure, make them available;
- ✓ Use the pulpit and parish bulletin messages, found in the Family of Faith Publicity Manual each week to keep your parishioners in touch with the current phase of the campaign.



Are your parish volunteers making calls to follow up on Special Phase and General Phase mailings?

- ✓ Timely follow up after the mailings is important to ensure success;
- ✓ Calls should be made within 7-10 days;
- ✓ Instead of leaving a voicemail on the first try when calling a parishioner, call back later and try again;
- ✓ If you leave voicemail when you call a parishioner, be sure to leave your number or the parish number;
- ✓ Smile when you call! Yes, people can *hear* you smile ☺
- ✓ Calls to parishioners are also wonderful ways to connect with old friends or to help a parishioner in need. There have been many examples in parishes where parishioners who need help have connected with their parish on matters ranging from information about sacramental preparation programs to home communion.

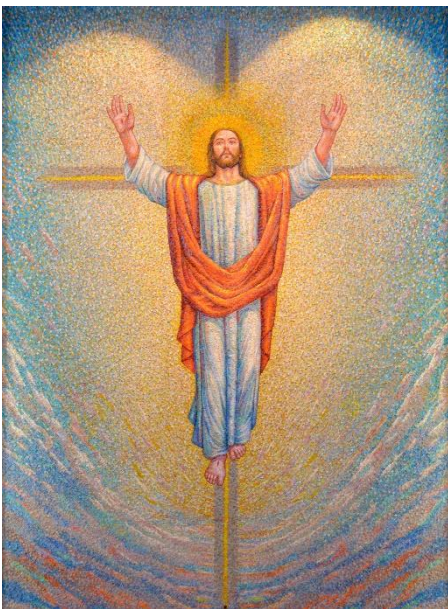
