



Campaign Progress

Wave 3 parishes had another excellent week, raising more than \$1.3 million for a new total of **\$15.6 million**. Wave 3 parishes have now raised **66%** or two thirds of their collective goal!

News You Can Use

Commitment Weekends will be held at Wave 3 parishes this weekend and throughout September. For many parishes, connecting with families to encourage participation in the campaign has been somewhat challenging. Summer schedules and vacations have often made it difficult to ‘close gifts.’ Many returning families may not have yet taken the opportunity to indicate their support for their parish’s Family of Faith campaign. That means that preparing for Commitment Weekend is critical to the success of a parish campaign. Pastors are encouraged to work with their Parish Campaign Director to best prepare for their Commitment Weekend. Parishes that follow the plan for Commitment Weekends can raise 20% of their parish goal or more.

‘Bricks and Mortar’: A frequent comment from prospective donors is that the Family of Faith campaign is too much about *bricks and mortar* and not enough about people. It’s true that significant resources are being dedicated to ensure church buildings across the archdiocese are in good shape and that new parishes receive a helping hand to get established.

It’s also true that the Family of Faith campaign plan is very much focused on other pressing needs. These range from youth ministry to new parish websites; from support for lay ministry to raising a Catholic voice in the public square; from establishing communications hubs to strengthening the bonds between parishes and schools.

Here are a few key points to consider when parishioners question the merits of investing in infrastructure:

- The campaign is providing \$25 million for the restoration of St. Michael’s Cathedral. Campaign funds are helping to ensure the structure is stable and safe for worship—not only for all Catholics in the archdiocese who visit our *mother church*, but for the thriving parish community that calls the cathedral home;
- Many parishes lack the funds necessary to properly maintain their buildings. If your house was in dire need of a new roof or furnace, would you not consider these items a priority for the safety and enjoyment of all who live there?
- The vast majority of parish campaigns will address various shortcomings in the condition of the church or parish hall. Projects include: electrical upgrades; plumbing repairs; accessibility for those with special needs; roofing; heating, ventilation and air conditioning, structural/building envelope repairs;
- Donors are encouraged to continue to support the weekly parish offertory and special collections like ShareLife. This year, support for ShareLife remained virtually unchanged due to the generosity of parishioners right across the archdiocese.

Wave 3 Campaign Updates
