



Campaign Progress

Please note: The next edition of Family Update will be published the week of **September 14th**. Monday, September 7th is Labour Day and that week marks the start of a new school year for hundreds of thousands of Catholic students across the archdiocese. The Family of Faith campaign office team wishes everyone a good long weekend and a terrific start to the school year.

Wave 3 parishes have now reached **71%** of their collective goal. Congratulations! 27 of the 68 parishes have surpassed their goals. More than half have achieved **75%** or more. Many Commitment Weekends will take place in September, providing a big boost to our Wave 3 parishes as they wrap up their campaigns.

Overall, the campaign has raised **\$112.4 million**.

Wave 3 Campaign Updates



St. Mary's Polish Parish has many talented children and Youth. Their spiritual development is a key priority for the parish. With part of its campaign share, the parish will establish a choir program for children and youth.

St. Mary's Polish Parish, Toronto: Having raised \$9,100 over the past week, Fr. Brzozowski is happy to report that the parish has now surpassed its campaign goal of \$105,000! This success was only made possible due to the diligent work of all involved. With three weeks remaining in the campaign, there is still more success to come.

St. Stanislaus Kostka, Toronto: Congratulations to Fr. Kurzydlo for having secured a \$50,000 gift to the campaign! The response of parishioners has been very positive throughout, and it shows—the parish has just achieved 130% of its goal.

St. Elizabeth Seton Parish, Newmarket: Father Roberts and volunteers have now surpassed \$378,000 in gifts and pledges. The parish is now at 72% of its goal and collected 10 pledges for \$19,800 this past week. Everyone is realizing how publicity and follow-up phone calls are essential to running a successful campaign.

St. Timothy's Parish, Toronto: Fr. Vandenakker and his volunteers are delighted that the parish is officially over its goal! The response from the parishioners has been amazing and the Campaign Executive Committee (CEC) looks forward to sharing the parish's final total.

Immaculate Conception Parish, Woodbridge: Father Chitteth and his CEC team are organizing the 'Family of Faith Pasta Night', which is a great opportunity for parishioners to learn more about the campaign while enjoying a fun evening of pasta, Italian sausage and wine.

St. Boniface Parish, Scarborough: Father Lee and a committed team of volunteers are making over 900 calls to Special Phase donors. The response has been very good. Keep up the great efforts.

Saviour of the World, Mississauga: Fr. Lung and his volunteers have now followed up with the remaining parishioners who pledged on Commitment Weekend. This helped the parish document another \$50,000 in pledges and took them over \$500,000, to 192% of the parish goal. Congratulations.

St. Jerome's, Brampton: The parish received more than 10 additional pledges in the last week. This was largely due to parishioners in the Special Phase returning their pledge forms after hearing more about the campaign at Masses and receiving phone calls from a volunteer.

The parish has raised almost 90% of its campaign goal with the Commitment Weekend still two weeks away.
