

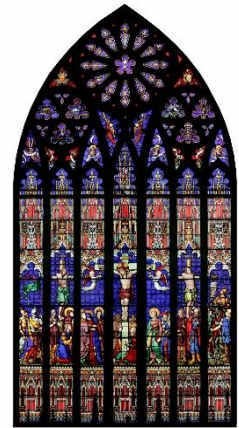


Campaign Progress

Wave 3 parishes have now reached **91%** of their collective goal. Congratulations! Many Commitment Weekends took place this past weekend and the results were very encouraging. Results will be included in next week's edition of Family Update.

Overall, the campaign has raised **\$117.2 million**.

Wave 4 Parish Campaign Tips

Here are some tips and reminders for parishes as they begin their Wave 4 campaigns:

- CEC members and volunteers are the 'backbone' to parish campaigns. Working with their Parish Campaign Directors, pastors should carefully select parishioners with the knowledge, passion and capacity to contribute to the success of their campaign;
- A timely follow-up with prospective donors is critical to a successful campaign. Schedule follow-up discussions to receive a gift decision within one week to ten days;

Know the plan: The Family of Faith campaign includes so many elements that will interest and engage parishioners. Knowledgeable pastors and volunteers are the campaign's strongest and best ambassadors.

It's very important to understand the difference between the Archdiocese of Toronto's Pastoral Plan and the Family of Faith campaign plan. Every priority of the Family of Faith plan is found in the pastoral plan. *However*, not every pastoral plan initiative is funded through the Family of Faith campaign.

- Parishes are very busy places! Ensure rooms and resources are booked well in advance so that meetings can be held in the right place at the agreed upon times with your Parish Campaign Director;
- Even though most Wave 4 parishes are in the 'quiet' phase, parishioners are still becoming more aware of the Family of Faith campaign with each passing week. The campaign is no secret! Don't hesitate to display our Family of Faith posters so that parishioners can be directed to visit the campaign website, and;
- Pastors are reminded that details regarding their parish campaigns should be shared with parishioners according to the campaign plan. The Publicity Manual issued to each parish provides strategically timed announcements.

Wave 3 Campaign Updates

Holy Redeemer Parish, Pickering: Congratulations to Fr. Mruma and the entire campaign team who recently conducted the parish's Commitment Weekend. The parish raised an additional \$35,000 in pledges, bringing the total raised to over \$450,000 or 123% of its campaign goal. A tremendous example of the *family of faith* in action.

St. Norbert's Parish, North York: Fr. Philip and the Campaign Executive Committee (CEC) have made preparations for the final phase of their parish campaign, which will conclude with their Commitment Weekend. The parish has already raised \$89,280 or 48% of its campaign goal. Expectations are high that the generosity of parishioners on the Commitment Weekend will help bring them past their parish goal.

St. Maximilian Kolbe Parish, Mississauga: Congratulations to Fr. Blazejak and his dedicated group of volunteers as the parish has now surpassed \$500,000! Through the hard work of many, the campaign is generating a lot of excitement and parishioners look forward to learning more about this initiative.

St. Stanislaus Kostka Parish, Toronto: With Commitment Weekend still to come, a further \$32,000 was raised this past week, putting the parish at 144% of its goal! Everyone is thrilled to experience this success, and look forward to achieving even more.

St. Jerome's Parish, Brampton: With Commitment Weekend still to come, over \$80,000 in additional pledges was committed last week. This was the result of the hard work by Fr. Kolodynski and his volunteers in recent weeks. The whole team has worked hard to reach out to parishioners to ensure they are well informed and to encourage decisions.

St. Boniface Parish, Scarborough – Father Lee had great success on the Commitment Weekend. On the weekend of September 12th and 13th he was able to raise 44% of his goal! Congratulations to the whole team of dedicated volunteers.

St. Mary's Parish, Toronto: Fr. Couto and his volunteer team reached 102% of the parish goal this past week. Congratulations on this success!

Immaculate Conception Parish, Woodbridge: Father Chitteth and his team raised 42% of the parish's goal in the past two weeks. The parish is now at 71% of its goal. Many thanks to a great team effort which included Bishop Kirkpatrick's visit, a Family of Faith campaign Pasta Night with 200 attendees, and the Commitment Weekend.

St Rose of Lima Parish, Scarborough: Father Claudio and his team were elated to receive \$55,950 in pledges after Commitment Weekend. They have now achieved 115% of their goal with \$900,000 in their sights.

St. Gregory the Great Parish, Oshawa: The parish and Father O'Brien are approaching their goal of \$410,000! After a successful Commitment Weekend of raising \$107,400, the parish is at 94% of its goal.
