



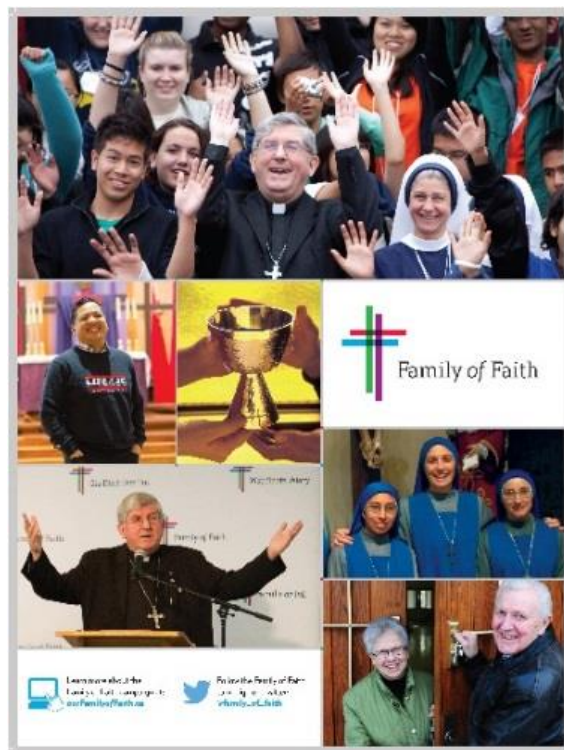
Campaign Progress

Important Information for Wave 4 Parishes

Next week's edition of Family Update will include Wave 4 parishes that have raised gifts and pledges to date in their campaigns. Many of these forty-plus parishes are already well into their campaigns, engaging Major Phase and Advance Phase prospective donors and establishing their Campaign Executive Committees (CECs). Several others are in the earlier stages of their campaigns, now getting underway in early October.



Here are some tips and reminders for pastors with parishes in Wave 4:

- CEC members and volunteers are the 'backbone' to parish campaigns. Working with their Parish Campaign Directors, pastors should carefully select parishioners with the knowledge, passion and capacity to contribute to the success of their campaign;
- A timely follow-up with prospective donors is critical to a successful campaign. Schedule follow-up discussions within a week to ten days;
- Parishes are busy places! Ensure rooms and resources (eg. projectors, screens and laptops) are booked well in advance so that meetings can be held in the right place at the scheduled times;
- Know the plan: The Family of Faith campaign includes so many elements that will interest and engage parishioners. Knowledgeable pastors and volunteers are the campaign's strongest and best ambassadors; and
- Many prospective donors may want the advantage of a 2015 tax receipt. When meeting with parishioners, keep this in mind so that donors can benefit from charitable tax receipts issued for Family of Faith campaign donations.

Combined Campaigns Explained

In response to questions from readers, we are pleased to explain Combined Campaigns.

Some parishes have extraordinary fundraising needs and have the capacity to raise far more than their standard Family of Faith goal. Typically, such parishes want to raise three or four times their annual offertory in a major capital campaign. To be successful, these campaigns may require additional professional fundraising counsel at a cost borne by the parish.

The sharing formula for Combined Campaigns is different from a standard campaign. In a standard campaign, the parish receives 25% of funds raised up to its goal and 75% of funds raised thereafter. In a Combined Campaign, the parish must guarantee its archdiocesan contribution and its share of campaign costs.

In a Combined Campaign, the proceeds are shared as follows: The archdiocese will receive funds up to a parish's share (75%) of the standard goal and the parish will receive the balance of funds (25%) up to its standard goal and all remaining funds up to its established Combined Campaign goal. A list of current Combined Campaign parishes is found below. Others will be added in the coming weeks.



St. Gertrude's Parish in Oshawa is running a combined campaign. Fr. Peter Choi's plans include debt retirement and programs for youth and seniors.
