



Campaign Progress

All 68 Wave 3 parishes are included in this week's edition of Family Update.

Overall, the campaign has raised gifts and pledges of **\$96.6 million** or **92%** of the Family of Faith campaign's goal. The three parishes running active Combined Campaigns have raised **\$4.9 million** and achieved **82%** of their collective goal. Wave 3 parishes have raised over **\$1.9 million**, which is **8%** of their collective goal.

Wave 2 parishes have raised **150%** of their collective goal with just over \$40 million in donations and pledges. 49 of 58 Wave 2 parishes have surpassed their goals. Congratulations to all pastors, volunteers and donors to the Wave 2 Family of Faith parishes.

Timely Tips for Wave 3 Parishes



The Newman Centre in Toronto will use part of its share of proceeds from its Family of Faith campaign to pay down its debt to the archdiocese, owed for roof repairs.

Here are some tips and reminders for parishes in Wave 3:

- CEC members and volunteers are the 'backbone' to parish campaigns. Working with their Parish Campaign Directors, pastors should carefully select parishioners with the knowledge, passion and capacity to contribute to the success of their campaign;
- A timely follow-up with prospective donors is critical to a successful campaign. Schedule follow-up discussions to receive a gift decision within one week to ten days;
- Parishes are very busy places! Ensure rooms and resources are booked well in advance so that meetings can be held in the right place at the agreed upon times with your Parish Campaign Director;

- Even though most Wave 3 parishes are in the 'quiet phase' parishioners are still becoming more aware of the Family of Faith campaign with each passing week. The campaign is no secret! Don't hesitate to hang up some of our Family of Faith posters so that parishioners can be directed to visit the campaign website, and;
- Pastors are reminded that details regarding their parish campaigns should be shared with parishioners according to the campaign plan. The Publicity Manual issued to each parish provides strategically timed announcements.

Know the plan: The Family of Faith campaign includes so many elements that will interest and engage parishioners. Knowledgeable pastors and volunteers are the campaign's strongest and best ambassadors.

It's very important to understand the difference between the Archdiocese of Toronto's Pastoral Plan and the Family of Faith campaign plan. Every priority of the Family of Faith plan is found in the pastoral plan. *However*, not every pastoral plan initiative is funded through the Family of Faith campaign.

Wave 3 Campaign Updates

St. Teresa's Parish, Etobicoke: Fr. Gabriel and Fr. Matthew convened the Campaign Executive Committee for the first time last week. The volunteers are looking forward to bringing the full church community closer together.

St. Timothy's Parish, Toronto: Fr. Roger and the Campaign Executive Committee are conducting visits in the major phase of the campaign. The full team looks forward to building on the momentum from the \$79,600 raised to date!

St. Joseph's, Beaverton: Fr. Oswin Fernandes has fully embraced the Family of Faith campaign and kicked off activity by meeting with 12 of the parish's most generous families this past week. They are looking forward to carrying out a successful campaign.

Nativity of Our Lord, Etobicoke: Fr. Michael Machacek and his team of Campaign Executive Committee (CEC) members have already made significant progress towards their goal, raising \$134,000 or 27% this week from only eleven gifts. Congratulations on this milestone!

St. Thomas Aquinas, Toronto: Father Dibenedetto and volunteers had an incredibly successful Advance Gift Orientation with 17 families in attendance. Additionally, Father has been able to visit 15 families in the major phase. Now Father and volunteers are focusing on following-up and encouraging families to make their gifts within 5-7 days.

Newman Centre Catholic Mission, Toronto: Fr. Cauchi has enthusiastically embraced the campaign and has made tremendous strides at the Newman Centre. Through Fr. Cauchi's personal efforts, he has already raised 22% of his parish's \$180,000 goal.

St. Bartholomew, Agincourt: Fr. Foley held his CEC orientation last week – where 20 parish families attended! Father and the volunteers are enthusiastic and eager to begin their leadership efforts!

St. Anne's, Brampton: In just one week, Fr. Cherickal raised nearly \$150,000, surpassing 25% prior to his CEC orientation last week. Volunteers are looking forward to getting the campaign started in the weeks ahead.

St. Joan of Arc, Toronto: Father Callahan has raised 18% of his goal in a very short time, through personal visits to Major donors. He has recently formed a committee, with a dedicated team of volunteers, to continue the success of the campaign.

Sts. Cyril and Methodius, Mississauga: Fr. Vano is off to a fantastic start! With his hard work and dedicated staff and volunteers, they have raised 20% of goal!

St. Joseph the Worker, Thornhill: Fr. Mario recently met with 14 parishioners who volunteered to give of their time and talent in support of the Family of Faith Campaign. They have been trained how to conduct personal visits with other parishioners. To date, Fr. Mario along with his staff and volunteers have raised over \$280,000, which is almost half-way to the parish's campaign goal of \$600,000.

Holy Cross, Toronto: Fr. Roselle has assembled a group of parishioners who have volunteered to be part of the Campaign Executive Committee. To date, Fr. Roselle has raised \$46,000, which represents over 20% of the parish's goal. With verbal gifts included, Fr. Roselle has raised one-third of the parish's goal.
