



Campaign Progress

Wave 3 parishes have raised over **\$2.9 million** in donations and pledges, which is **12%** of their collective goal.

The three parishes running active Combined Campaigns have raised **\$5.0 million** and achieved **85%** of their collective goal. Wave 2 parishes have raised **150%** of their collective goal with just over \$40 million in donations and pledges.

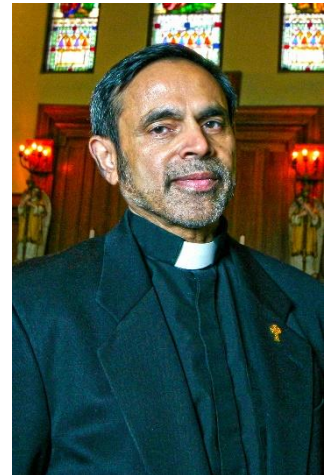
Overall, the campaign has raised gifts and pledges of **\$97.7 million** or **93%** of the Family of Faith campaign's goal.

Reminders for Wave 1 and 2 Parishes

Parishes that ran Wave 1 and Wave 2 Family of Faith campaigns continue to receive new gifts and pledge payments in their parish offices. These pledges are important to the continuing success of parish campaigns and should be processed on a timely basis.

All parishes have received pledge forms, Record of Subscription forms, Weekly Transmittal forms and envelopes that are pre-addressed to the Donations Processing Centre.

Parishes are asked to forward new pledges and payments received in the parish office to the Donations Processing Centre on a weekly basis, even after the active phase of their campaign has been completed.



St. Andrew's, Brechin: Fr. Gonsalves and his CEC team have led the first Wave 3 parish to exceed its goal. They raised \$72,500 (134%) from just five families, including four gifts from CEC members. Congratulations!

Wave 3 Campaign Updates



St. Stanislaus Kostka, Toronto: Fr. Kurzydlo and campaign volunteers recently surpassed the 50% mark of their goal of \$235,000! With **\$37,000** raised over the past week and 21 families that were welcomed to a recent orientation meeting, everyone is excited about its true potential.

St. Margaret Mary, Woodbridge: Fr. Grayda received more than **\$60,000** in gifts last week, including two gifts from Campaign Executive Committee (CEC) members, putting the parish over **60%** of its goal.

Nativity of Our Lord, Etobicoke: Fr. Michael Machacek and his CEC hosted an enthusiastic Major Gift Orientation meeting this past Wednesday. Thanks to reminder calls from the team, most of the invited parishioners were in attendance. To date, the majority of CEC members have made a gift to the campaign, and are inspiring others to make their most sacrificial gift.

St. Joseph the Worker Parish in Thornhill is more than half way (53%) to its \$600,000 goal. Congratulations!

St. Pius X, Toronto: Fr. Park and his CEC are working hard to recruit more volunteers, and have two new committee members joining the team this week to assist in visiting all Advance Phase parishioners by Canada Day. Fr. Park is leaving the parish for a new assignment at the end of June and his campaign is in great shape, thanks to his leadership and dedication.

St. Elizabeth of Hungary, North York: Fr. Jenó hosted a Major Phase Orientation this past Monday, and his CEC members shared their personal reflections on the campaign thus far. The campaign also marked an important milestone when it received the first gift from a member from a CEC member. Keep up the good work!

Holy Redeemer, Pickering: Fr. Colman, along with the CEC, have raised over **\$60,000** toward the parish goal of \$370,000. CEC members have personally contributed almost \$45,000. Congratulations to the entire team for their strong leadership and support of the campaign. The parish recently held its Advanced Gift Orientation Meeting, where approximately 50 people were introduced to the campaign.

St. Joseph's, Beaverton: Fr. Oswin has been busy this past week, meeting with parishioners in the Major and Advance phase individually and in small groups. He is looking forward to announcing his first gift to the campaign next week.

St. Andrew's, Brechin: Thanks to the perseverance and tireless dedication of Fr. Anthony and his team of CEC members, St. Andrew's is the first Wave 3 parish to exceed its goal, raising **\$72,500** (134%) from five families, including four CEC gifts to the campaign. Congratulations!

St. Paul's Basilica, Toronto: A successful Advanced Gift Orientation Meeting was held at the basilica with over 25 parishioners in attendance. Fr. McDevitt, along with General Chair Ed Scheck, presented campaign details to parishioners. To date, the team has raised over **\$100,000** in pledges toward the parish goal of \$295,000, with another big week projected. Truly strong leadership is being shown by Fr. Frank and the CEC.



St. Martin of Tours, Mississauga: Fr. Joyson and his CEC have hit the ground running this week, assigning visitors to all Major Gift prospects. Several members of the CEC have already contributed their gift to the campaign – to be announced next week!

Immaculate Conception, Sutton West: Fr. Sherwin has been working hard these past few weeks, meeting with parishioners in the Leadership and Major phase and sharing his enthusiasm for the Family of Faith campaign. Fr. Sherwin will host an Advance Phase Orientation on Thursday this week and is looking forward to announcing his first gift to the campaign at that time.

St. Mary's, Toronto: The CEC of St. Mary's Parish is doing a great job requesting donations. Joe Oliveira, the General Chairman, has recently assigned some of the Parish Council members to visit parishioners.

St. Mary's Polish Parish, Toronto: The parish has reached **51%** of its goal from only 13 gifts, with **\$29,000** raised in the last week alone. The CEC is well poised and excited to continue this success, and looks forward to not only reaching its goal, but exceeding it.

St. Monica's, Toronto: Fr. Damian held his CEC Orientation last week. Volunteers are excited to begin meeting with their fellow parishioners to share with them the components of the Family of Faith campaign.

St. John the Evangelist, Whitby: St. John the Evangelist had a fantastic week. Not only did they receive 10 gifts from their CEC members for **\$64,000**, they also had over 20 families attend their Major Gift Orientation. To date, they have received \$100,000 in pledges.

St. James, Toronto: Father Pineda received two pledges from CEC members for a total of **\$26,500**. The committee has now raised over 10% of the campaign goal, which was its first financial benchmark.

St. Timothy's, Toronto: The full CEC has made pledges in support of the campaign, collectively raising over **\$50,000**. The parish continues to see terrific progress each week.

St. Mark's, Toronto: All volunteers have made pledges toward the Family of Faith campaign! The parish is beginning calling efforts next week to build on this terrific participation.
