



## Campaign Progress

Wave 3 parishes have raised **\$5.3 million** in donations and pledges, **23%** of their collective goal. 17 parishes have already achieved **50%** or more of their parish goal.

The three parishes currently running Combined Campaigns have raised **\$5.4 million** and achieved **90%** of their collective goal. Wave 2 parishes have raised **150%** of their collective goal with just over **\$40 million** in donations and pledges.

Overall, the campaign has raised gifts and pledges of **\$100.5 million** or **96%** of the Family of Faith campaign's minimum goal.

## Important Information for all Pastors

Many parishioners make gifts to their parish campaigns late in the active phase—often many weeks or months after Commitment Weekends. And, many parishioners have been making—and will continue to make—payments on pledges via their parish in the years to come.

So many of these payments are submitted by parishioners as part of the weekly parish offertory. Currently, a high number of these payments either take very long to arrive at the campaign's Donations Processing Centre or they get deposited into the parish offertory account in error. To help ensure your parishioner's donations are processed on a timely basis and properly credited to the parish's Family of Faith campaign please:

- ✓ Ensure you keep a ready supply of our Family of Faith envelopes on hand for parishioners\*
- ✓ Alert your volunteers/staff who count offertory collections to the fact that parishioners are submitting their payments in the regular offertory. Therefore, close scrutiny of envelopes and cheques is very important.
- ✓ When you receive a payment or pledge at the parish, send it to the Donations Processing Centre as soon as possible using the provided Record of Subscription forms\*

## Wave 3 Campaign Updates

**Holy Redeemer Parish, Pickering:** Fr. Colman, along with his Campaign Executive Committee (CEC) raised over \$45,000 from 7 gifts in the past week. With the strong leadership of Fr. Colman and the CEC the campaign is gaining momentum. Preparation is underway for the Special Gift Orientation Meeting that is scheduled to take place in mid-July.

**Holy Cross Parish, Toronto:** The campaign reached a big milestone this past week, crossing over the 50% mark of its \$190,000 goal. The CEC will now meet with the roughly 60 parishioners in the Advanced Phase. Great work by Fr. Roselle and the whole team.

**Church of the Resurrection Parish, Toronto:** Fr. Jonas and the volunteers continue to visit with Major Phase and Advance Phase parishioners after Mass. The team looks forward to recording their first pledges soon!

**St. Timothy's Parish, Toronto:** The volunteers are doing a terrific job conducting visits and closing decisions with their fellow parishioners. The parish is well on the way to raising \$250,000 by Canada Day.

**St. Mark's Parish, Etobicoke:** The parish raised over \$50,000 in one weekend, bringing the parish to 87% of its goal. Fr. Koroway and the volunteers look forward to celebrating the conclusion of a successful campaign at the end of the month.

**St. John the Evangelist, Whitby:** Volunteers and Father Ali were very pleased with their advance gift orientation attendance. 39 families attended the orientation and were engaged throughout the presentation. The parish has now received over **\$183,000** in pledges.

**St. Rose of Lima, Scarborough:** 29 families attended the advance gift orientation meeting. Father Claudio and volunteers continue to receive a growing support of parishioners that want to sacrifice their time, talent and treasure to help strengthen our *family of faith*.

**Santa Cruz Parish, Toronto -** Father Manuel reached 116% of his parish goal after a successful Commitment Weekend.

**St. Anne's, Brampton:** Fr. Cherickal was excited to welcome 25 families to his advance gift orientation. Parishioners heard about the campaign and were invited to come back to a meeting this week to learn more about how to become a volunteer and begin meeting with their fellow parishioners to spread the message of the campaign.

**St. Monica's Parish, Toronto:** During the week of his advance gift orientation meeting, Fr. Damian did not lose sight of closing decisions on those parishioners still pending from Major Gift visits that he made. This allowed him to receive an additional \$62,000 in pledges in the last week.

**St. Mary's Parish, Toronto -** The advance gift orientation meeting took place on Friday June 19th, attended by 35 parishioners. Father Fernando enthusiastically talked about the campaign and about the parish renovations, followed by video presentation and refreshments. The campaign video was also presented at the Masses on Saturday and Sunday.
