Attention Readers: The next edition of Family Update will be published the week of July 13, 2015. Happy Canada Day!

Wave 3 parishes have raised **\$6.5 million** in donations and pledges, **28%** of their collective goal.

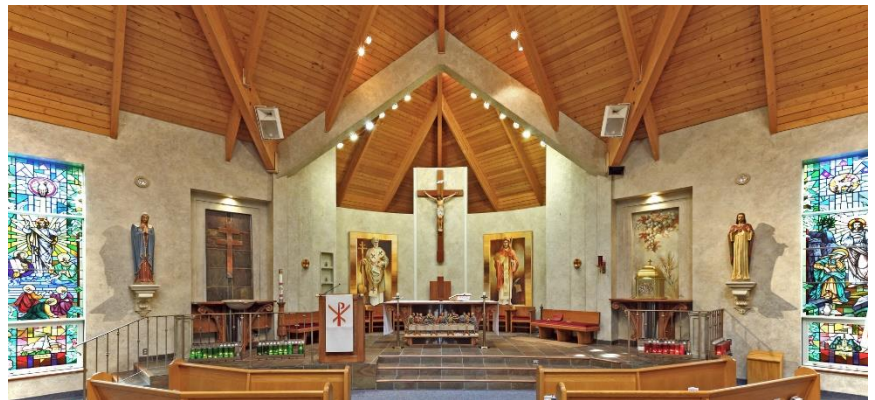
Combined Campaigns have now raised **\$10.25 million** and achieved **103%** of their collective goal. (Please note that henceforth, our Combined Campaign charts in Family Update will include both active and completed campaigns.)

Overall, the campaign has raised gifts and pledges of **\$101.6 million** or **97%** of the Family of Faith campaign's minimum goal.

Wave 3 Tips

Pastors and volunteers have been hearing a lot from their Parish Campaign Directors about the importance of 'getting gift decisions' or 'closing gifts.' That's because timely follow-up really does result in more support for parish campaigns.

After a parishioner has been invited to participate in the campaign, personal follow-up should take place between 5 and 7 days. That gives the parishioner time to reflect on and pray about their decision. Waiting longer does not communicate the importance of campaign. The sooner the gift is closed, the sooner the gift can be recorded and celebrated.

Wave 3 Campaign Updates

St. John the Evangelist, Waubaushene: Father Magyar and his parish team exceeded their \$55,000 goal and have now raised \$60,000. Congratulations!

St. Mary's Parish (Victoria Harbour) and **St. Louis Mission** (Mount St. Louis): The parish exceeded its \$50,000 joint goal and has now raised \$59,700.

St. Boniface Parish, Scarborough: Father Lee has recruited 30 volunteers to make Advance Phase visits with parishioners.

Santa Cruz Parish, Toronto: Due to excellent follow-up with parishioners and a highly successful Commitment Weekend, the parish has achieved 124% of its goal.

Christ the King Parish, Etobicoke: Fr. Chudy hosted his final orientation meeting as pastor before he moves on to his new assignment. Another 6 volunteers were recruited to help with phone calls and communications to build on the \$78,000 the parish has already raised.

St. Timothy's Parish, Toronto: Fr. Roger and his volunteers surpassed their benchmark of \$250,000 one week ahead of projection! The volunteers continue to do an amazing job visiting with parishioners and closing gift decisions. The team looks forward to a successful conclusion of the campaign.

St. Gregory the Great Parish, Oshawa: Father O'Brien received two gifts from pending parishioners, including a committee members, for **\$20,500**. The parish has achieved 13% of its goal and looks forward to their continued success!

Nativity of Our Lord Parish, Etobicoke: Fr. Michael Machacek hosted an enthusiastic major gift orientation session on last Wednesday. Thanks to the encouraging phone reminders made by Campaign Executive Committee (CEC) members, 51 parishioners were in attendance.

St. Pius X Parish, Toronto: Fr. Park and his CEC had an exceptionally successful week, with 25 per cent of goal raised! Fr. Park has departed for his new parish assignment. Thanks to his dedication, his team is in great shape as they begin phone-a-thon sessions.

St. Margaret Mary Parish, Woodbridge: Fr. Grayda is excited to announce that through the hard work of his generous parishioners, the parish surpassed its goal! Now that they are over goal and 75% of funds raised over-goal come back to the parish, they will be able to do even more at the parish. Congratulations!
