



## Campaign Progress

Wave 3 parishes have raised **\$10.7 million** in donations and pledges. Congratulations to all of the Wave 3 parishes that are working so hard and have now achieved **45%** of their collective goal!

Overall, the campaign has raised gifts and pledges totalling **\$106.2 million**. Congratulations to all clergy, volunteers and donors who have supported the Family of Faith campaign.



### Summer 2015 video Update:

In our new video, Cardinal Collins notes that roughly half of the parishes in the archdiocese have yet to complete their Family of Faith campaigns. Wave 3, now underway, is being conducted in almost 70 parishes. Another 50 parishes will conduct their campaigns in the fall. The campaign's financial success to date is largely based on parish campaigns that, thus far, have raised approximately 150% of their collective goal.

The success of the parish campaigns to date can give great confidence to the parishes that are now running or will soon run their own parish campaigns. The generous donors and committed clergy leading their parish campaigns are telling us that in their words, actions and success in meeting and exceeding their goals.

It is important to follow-up within 7 to 10 days of a gift request. Prospective donors need some time to reflect on their gift but waiting too long for follow-up does not communicate the importance of the request.

## Wave 3 Updates

**St. Timothy's Parish**, Toronto: The Campaign Executive Committee (CEC) and Fr. Vandenakker have been hard at work closing gifts and making phone calls as the campaign enters its final weeks. The parish has raised over \$400,000 toward its goal of \$655,000 and looks forward to celebrating a successful Commitment Weekend next month.

**St. Mary's**, Victoria Harbour and **St. Louis Mission**, Mt. St. Louis: The parish exceeded its goal of \$50,000 by raising \$81,100. As the campaign continues, Father Magyar and the Campaign Executive Committee (CEC) expect the total raised to climb higher. Keep up the great work!

**St. John the Evangelist**, Waubaushene: The parish has exceeded its \$55,000 goal by raising \$73,000. Congratulations!

**St. Patrick's Parish**, Perkinsfield: Fr. John Asadoorian had a successful Commitment Weekend raising \$32,650, bringing his parish's total to \$85,600, well over their goal of \$78,000. Great job Fr. John!

**St. Jerome's**, Brampton: Fr. Jan and volunteers welcomed about 35 people to its Special Phase orientation last week. They learned about the Family of Faith campaign case and how they can help serve in a volunteer role as a parish caller to continue spreading the campaign message.

**St. Rose of Lima**, Scarborough: This past week, the parish had another big week for the campaign by raising \$98,150. The parish has reached 51% of its goal. Everyone involved in the campaign looks forward to build upon this previous success.

**St. James**, Toronto: The parish has surpassed its target! St. James raised \$103,940 during Commitment Weekend, which is over 46% of their goal in one weekend. The parish has now received \$286,000 in pledges on a goal of \$220,000.

**St. Mark's Parish**, Etobicoke: Following a successful Commitment Weekend, the parishioners continue to be generous to the campaign. To date, the parish has raised 140% of its goal!
