



## Campaign Progress

Welcome to Volume 4 of Family Update, the weekly summary of activity in the Family of Faith campaign. Beginning this week, Wave 4 parishes that have raised funds are included in Family Update. Next week, we'll post the names of all Wave 4 parishes. Our Combined Campaigns chart has also been updated in this edition.

20 Wave 4 parishes have raised a total of **\$1.23 million**, which is **7%** of the collective goal of \$17.9 million for the wave.

Wave 3 parishes continue to show impressive progress as Commitment Weekend results are confirmed. Collectively, they have raised **\$25.3 million**, or **108%** of the Wave 3 goal.

## Wave 4 Campaign Updates

**St. Padre Pio Parish, Kleinburg:** The parish had a successful first Campaign Executive Committee (CEC) orientation meeting last week. Msgr. Ace talked about the importance of the campaign and about his own commitment, being the first one to donate.

**St. John the Baptist Parish, Toronto:** Father Perez's diligent work is showing results. After three meetings with his parishioners he has raised 13% of his goal. Father has a dedicated team of volunteers to raise awareness about the campaign and engage the Hispanic community.

**Holy Family Parish, Whitby:** Congratulations to Fr. Nagy and the CEC who have raised over 20% of the parish goal of \$620,000. The parish recently held a successful major gift orientation meeting. Fr. Nagy, Fr. Sisko and the CEC are now hard at work, visiting major gift prospects. Keep up the great work!

**St. Alphonsus Parish, Toronto:** Fr. Reposkey has started visiting parishioners and making phone calls prior to the parish's major phase orientation this week. With \$17,000 raised thus far and several pending gifts to be followed-up on, Fr. Reposkey continues to visit parishioners in the major phase, and is busy preparing for other orientation sessions.

**St. Clare's Parish, Toronto:** The parish held its major gift orientation in late September. Fr. De Pinto also presented the campaign to advance phase prospects this week. With the help of Deacon Gerry Almeida, CEC Chair, Fr. Pinto is starting to follow up personally on pledges and is recruiting volunteers.

**St. Mary Immaculate Parish**, Richmond Hill: Fr. Zborowski has led the campaign team to a fantastic start, raising nearly \$400,000 in the first month of visiting. Even with travel to see the Holy Father in the United States and a pilgrimage to Fatima and Lourdes commanding volunteers' time, the committee continues to make excellent progress.

**St. Ignatius Loyola Parish**, Mississauga: Fr. Hanley and his CEC have raised over \$268,000 (28%) toward the parish goal of \$960,000. CEC members have personally contributed \$225,000. The parish recently held its major gift orientation meeting, where roughly 30 parishioners attended the meeting. Congratulations to the entire team for its strong leadership and support of the campaign.

**St. Joseph's Parish**, Scarborough: Fr. Iwuchukwu hosted a very well attended major gift orientation this week. Coming on the heels of another recent parish fundraising campaign, the community is coming together to support the new initiatives outlined in the Family of Faith case for support.

**Immaculate Conception Parish**, Toronto: Fr. Pais has been able to meet with all of his major phase donors. As a result, the parish has raised almost 20% of its goal! Fr. Pais looks forward to continuing to raise funds towards his combined campaign.

**Epiphany of Our Lord Parish**, Scarborough: CEC members are starting to present the case to their fellow parishioners for the first time, and are enthusiastic about the response that they are getting as the campaign builds momentum.

**Our Lady Queen of Poland Parish**, Scarborough: The parish conducted its Commitment Weekend a few weeks ago and the results are now in. They are phenomenal, with a resounding response from the parish community raising over \$160,000 and surpassing its goal of \$305,000! Congratulations to Fr. Bobola and the entire volunteer team who have made this achievement possible!

**St. Hedwig's Parish**, Oshawa: Fr. Dabrowski held a very successful Commitment Weekend raising \$95,000, or 35% of the parish goal! He especially thanks the volunteers who have been working hard on the campaign for the past few months. Without them this achievement would not have been possible.
