



Campaign Progress

Overall, the campaign has raised gifts and pledges of **\$140.8 million**.

Collectively, the 42 Wave 4 parishes conducting standard campaigns have now raised **\$10.5 million** or **59%** of the wave's \$17.9 million goal.

Six parishes in the wave have exceeded their goals: St. Edward the Confessor Parish, North York; St. Alphonsus Parish, Toronto; St. Leo the Great Parish, Brooklin; Immaculate Heart of Mary Parish, Scarborough; St. Mary Immaculate Parish, Richmond Hill; and, St. Andre Bessette Parish, Maple. Congratulations to these parishes. Several more are expected to reach their goal in the next couple of weeks. When a parish exceeds its goal, 75% of funds raised above the goal may be used for parish priorities. Until the parish reaches its goal, 25% of funds raised are used for parish priorities.

St. Edward the Confessor, North York: Congratulations to Fr. O'Dea and all the campaign volunteers on surpassing their parish goal! Over \$100,000 was raised this past week, propelling the parish over its goal of \$535,000 for a total of \$604,000. Commitment and hard work from many parishioners has made this possible, and the parish is now well positioned as it heads into its Commitment Weekend.

St. Joseph Parish, Scarborough: Special thanks this week to John, the campaign chair, for his service and leadership. Heading into the final week before we break for Christmas, the parish has raised nearly \$250,000.

St. Patrick's Parish, Mississauga: There was a great turnout for the final orientation meeting. 58 families heard Fr. Facey and Bill Lawless, General Chair, present information about the Family of Faith campaign. Fr. Facey and the committee have been busy reaching out to parishioners in advance of Christmas. This hard work has resulted in over 50% of the campaign goal or roughly \$395,000 being raised. Keep up the great work!

Our Lady of Good Counsel Parish, Toronto: The parish has reached almost 90% of its \$115,000 goal. Father Guiseppi and his dedicated group of campaign volunteers hope that the generosity of their congregation will help them reach goal on their December 12 & 13 Commitment Weekend. The parish plans to use its share of campaign proceeds to reduce debt and cover the cost of repairing windows and other improvements.

Holy Spirit Parish, Barrie: With the campaign in its final weeks, Fr. Walczyk would like to thank the campaign team for making this initiative such a success! Commitment Weekend is yet to come, and already the parish has raised 95% of its goal, including almost 20% raised this past week alone.

St. Barnabas, Scarborough: As Fr. Park and his team head toward Christmas, there is much to celebrate in their campaign. They are already at 70% of their goal.

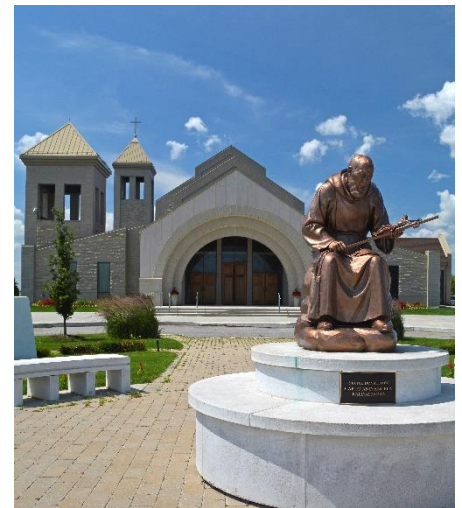

Family of Faith Campaign: Year-end Donation Processing Procedures

As we come to the end of the 2015 calendar year, here are important notes regarding procedures for processing contributions to the Family of Faith campaign over the next few weeks.

Gifts of Securities

Parishioners wishing to make a gift of securities to the Family of Faith campaign should contact Quentin Schesnuik at the Development Office (416.934.3400 x561, or quentins@archtoronto.org). **In order to be eligible for a 2015 tax receipt, we should receive the necessary paperwork by Thursday December 24 at 10 a.m.**

Cheques

In order to receive a 2015 tax receipt, cheques must be dated on or before December 31, 2015. The parish should receive the cheques on or before this date, or the postmark on the envelope should be dated December 31 or earlier. Cheques received at the Donation Processing Centre that are postmarked before December 31 will be eligible for a 2015 tax receipt.

Cheques received at the parish dated December 31 or earlier must be received at the Donation processing Centre by Friday January 15, 2016 in order to receive a 2015 tax receipt.

Credit Card and Direct Debit Transactions

Note: the following processes apply to payments that are intended for December, 2015. Pledges starting in January, 2016 or later will follow our normal procedures (first business day of the month.)

The Donations Processing Centre processes credit and debit card transactions on the first business day of the month. In the normal course of action, these would not be processed again until January 4, 2016.

As pledge forms arrive during the month of December for credit card and direct debit transactions, we will do the following:

Monthly donors: these will start on January 4, 2016; no contribution for 2015 will be made.

Quarterly, semi-annual, or annual donors: we will process a payment on December 31st, 2015, and the next payment will be according to their schedule:

Quarterly:	April 1, 2016
Semi Annually:	July 1, 2016
Annually:	December 1, 2016

We have a template letter/ that will be sent to parishioners where these situations take place.

For quarterly/semi-annual/annual payments that are received at the parish toward the end of December or received and postmarked before December 31, we will process a December 31 payment on January 15, and the next payment according to the schedule above. This payment will be eligible for a 2015 tax receipt. The parish should note the date received on the pledge form.

Monthly credit card or debit card transactions received at parish or at the Donation Processing Office after December 31, 2015 with a December start date will have their first payment on February 1, 2016.
