

## Campaign Progress

The Family of Faith campaign now stands at **\$154 million** raised in gifts and pledges. That's 147% of the minimum goal for the campaign.

27 of the 42 Wave 4 parishes conducting standard campaigns have now met or exceeded their parish goals. They have raised over **\$20 million**—116% of the wave's goal.

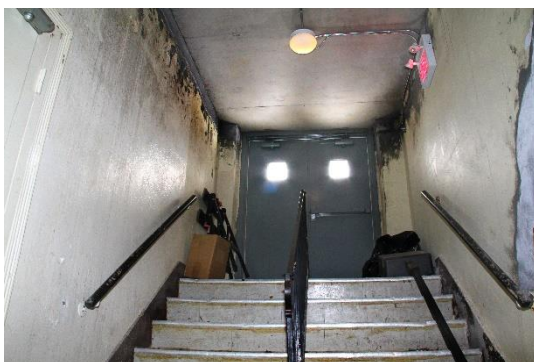
Active Combined Campaigns have raised 81% of their goals. Congratulations to Fr. Jan Gogolewski at Guardian Angels Parish in Brampton. This new parish community has raised \$359,792 against a goal of \$170,000. This is an amazing achievement.

## Family of Faith Funding for Parishes

**Youth Ministry:** The Archdiocese of Toronto's Pastoral Plan urges all parishes to identify leadership roles for youth, to form youth councils and to consider hiring youth ministers. The Family of Faith campaign is funding such initiatives through an investment of \$5 million over ten years. Annual subsidies of up to \$25,000 per parish are available. Parishes that need help to proceed with capital repairs and accessibility projects many be eligible for funding.

**Campaign support for parishes:** The Family of Faith campaign plan noted that some parishes face daunting expenditures to maintain facilities that are safe and secure.

Some parishes do not have the financial capacity to preserve their historic sacred spaces. Places of worship need to be fully accessible to those with special needs. That is why \$10 million will be dedicated to assist with capital improvements. Funds are available to support capital expenditures for churches, parish halls, and offices, especially where there are accessibility and heritage needs that must be addressed. Parishes with limited financial resources, including their reserves, will be given priority for the loans.

Funds are available through 5-year interest-free loans after which interest will begin to accrue as with other loans to parishes. To apply, parishes must submit the standard Request for Approval (RFA) document for capital expenditures along with a cover memo explaining why the parish should receive a loan. Parishes that are using funds from the parish share of their Family of Faith campaign are eligible for this loan. ## Timely Reminders: Please Read

Here are some timely reminders:

- Payments to Pilot, Wave 1 and Wave 2 parishes will be made in mid-February (for payments received to December 31, 2015.) More information to come.
- **2015 Year-end Donations and Eligibility for 2015 Tax Year Charitable Receipts: The Friday, January 15, 2016 deadline for cheques and pledge forms received by parishes has passed.** Cheques received from this point forward will be eligible for a **2016 tax receipt**.
- Active fundraising in most Wave 4 parish campaigns is wrapping up. While our Parish Campaign Directors are completing their on-site work in partnership with pastors and Campaign Executive Committees (CEC), many parishioners will continue to make their decisions and submit their pledge forms.
- Parishes should keep on hand a supply of parish campaign pledge forms, Record of Subscription form (electronic versions preferred) along with envelopes pre-addressed to the Family of Faith campaign office. Please remind those who count your parish offertory to be on the lookout for campaign donations—either noted as such on the cheque/envelope or because of donation amounts that are not in sync with the parishioner's usual pattern of weekly giving.
