



Campaign Progress

Overall, the campaign has raised gifts and pledges of **\$130.6 million**, an increase of **\$3.4 million** in the past week alone. This success is largely due to several Wave 3 parishes that are concluding their campaigns with very strong participation. 47 Wave 3 have met or exceeded their goals.

Collectively, the 42 Wave 4 parishes conducting standard campaigns also had an excellent week, raising more than \$1 million, for a total of **\$4.6 million** or **26%** of the wave's \$17.9 million goal.

All across the archdiocese, parishioners are responding with great support to the needs supported by the Family of Faith campaign. Pastors and their volunteer teams are doing a tremendous job of reaching out and sharing information about the campaign. A special thanks to the volunteers in parishes who are devoting countless hours, assisting their pastors in running information sessions, making donor visits, helping at Commitment Weekends and by making their own sacrificial gifts to the campaign.

Non-cash Year-end Gifts

In addition to cash gifts, the Family of Faith campaign accepts gifts of securities, insurance, gifts-in-kind, and annuities. Every prospective donor to the campaign has been provided with a copy of "Ways of Giving" brochure which provides a brief overview about the various options.

Pastors and volunteers who have been approached by prospective donors wishing to explore these non-cash gift options are encouraged to alert their Parish Campaign Director as soon as possible. The director will help ensure that specially trained archdiocesan staff work closely with the donor and/or their financial services representative.

Gifts of Securities:

Many donors choose to make their **securities** gifts near the end of the calendar year as it coincides with the tax year. To ensure that **securities** donors benefit from a 2015 charitable tax receipt, all necessary paperwork to complete the gift in 2015 must be received **no later than 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, December 24, 2015.**

Other Non-Cash Gifts:

Gifts of insurance, gifts in-kind and annuities also require advance planning to complete the donation process.

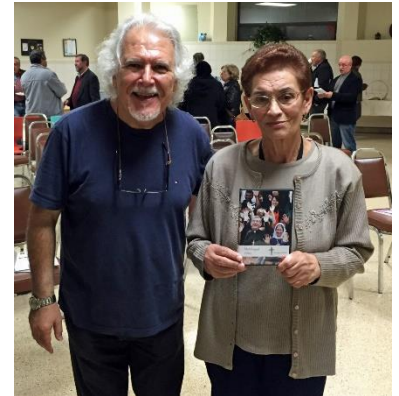
Some of the proceeds at St. Edward the Confessor Parish in North York will be used for much needed repairs to the church parking lot.

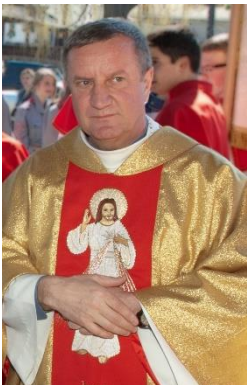
