



Campaign Progress

Collectively, the 42 Wave 4 parishes conducting standard campaigns have now raised **\$6.5 million** or **36%** of the wave's \$17.9 million goal.

Overall, the campaign has raised gifts and pledges of **\$134.3 million**.

Important Year-end Reminders

Reminder to parishes: Please note that all 2015 cheques dated on or before **Thursday, December 31** must be received at the Donation Processing Centre by **Friday January 15, 2016** to be included for a 2015 tax receipt! Most gifts to the campaign have been in the form of pledges, payable over five years. Tax receipts will be issued for the value of gift amounts received in the tax year.

We will be issuing 2015 tax receipts for Family of Faith donations by the **end of February 2016**.

Wave 2 parishes will be receiving their first payment and campaign reports in the mail this week. The package has been sent confidentially to pastors, and the funds will be placed in an account at the archdiocese under the parish name designated as Family of Faith funds. Over \$11 million has been received for Wave 2 parishes, with \$2.4 million paid to wave 2 parishes.

The next payment for **Pilot Phase, Wave 1** and **Wave 2** parishes will be as of December 31, 2015, with reports being sent and funds deposited by mid- February, 2016.

Weekly reports: Pastors and office staff at all parishes are reminded to send in payments **weekly** (new pledges and payments on existing pledges) using Record of Subscription forms. Timely submission helps ensure donors receive credit for their gifts as soon as possible. Delays may prompt the Donations Processing Centre to send needless reminder letters to donors who already made their payment directly at the parish.

Wave 4 Campaign Updates

St. Patrick's Parish, Mississauga: It was a big week for Fr. Facey and the Campaign Executive Committee (CEC) members, with over \$55,000 in pledges received. This brings the total pledges raised to \$242,200 or 31% of the parish's campaign goal. The committee continues to work hard to meet with parishioners and follow-up on visits to encourage a decision. Well done!

Immaculate Conception Parish, Port Perry: The parish hosted a very successful orientation meeting this past week, with over 40 families in attendance. Fr. Testa, along with campaign secretary Shirley Harvey, presented information about the campaign to all in attendance. The committee is now preparing to reach out to roughly 400 families in the next phase of their campaign. Keep up the great work!

St. Mary Immaculate Parish, Richmond Hill: Fr. Pawel has led his parish over their campaign goal with three weeks left of active fundraising.

Immaculate Heart of Mary Parish, Scarborough: Fr. Tammearu and his campaign team enter their commitment weekend at 75 % of their goal. They hope to surpass their goal this weekend.

St. Agnes Parish, Toronto: Fr. Garcia is organizing information sessions for his parishioners at the parish. All parishioners will have the opportunity to learn more about the campaign and listen to his presentation. A dedicated group of volunteers is preparing invitation letters and setting up the meetings.

St. John the Baptist Parish, Toronto: Father Pérez is getting ready for his Commitment Weekend that is happening on November 28th and 29th. Father has successfully engaged the parish's Spanish-speaking community in the campaign.

St. Brigid's Parish, Toronto: The parish received its first "matching gift" pledge from a generous parishioner/business owner who will match gifts received annually for the Family of Faith campaign from his employees. The matching gift will be equivalent to a maximum of \$2,400 per year or \$12,000 in five years. With the parish now at 47% of its goal, Fr. Sierra and the CEC team were excited to receive this additional unusual but generous gift.

St. Bonaventure Parish, Toronto: Fr. Stachurski has been visiting with families and the response has been supportive and encouraging. Over \$167,000 has been pledged this past week from early meetings and it is only the beginning! There is great potential to come and excitement is building.
