



## Campaign Progress

Collectively, the 42 Wave 4 parishes conducting standard campaigns have now raised **\$7.2 million** or **40%** of the wave's \$17.9 million goal. 17 of these parishes are 40% or more toward their goals. Congratulations to Fr. Pawel Zborowski and his campaign team at St. Mary Immaculate Parish in Richmond Hill, the latest parish to reach its goal.

Overall, the campaign has raised gifts and pledges of **\$135.7 million**.

## Year-end Reminders

**Very Important Information for Pastors and parish office staff:** Please note that all 2015 cheques dated on or before **Thursday, December 31** must be received at the Donation Processing Centre no later than **Friday January 15, 2016** to be included for a 2015 tax receipt! Most gifts to the campaign have been in the form of pledges, payable over five years. Tax receipts will be issued for the value of gift amounts **received in the tax year**.

We will be issuing 2015 tax receipts for Family of Faith donations by the **end of February 2016**. Tax receipts issued by the parish will not include any gifts to the Family of Faith campaign.

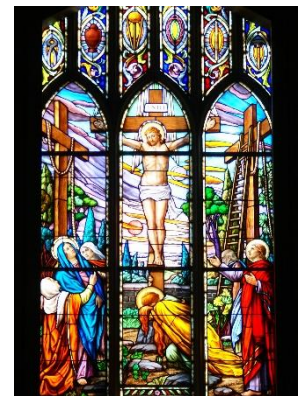
