



Campaign Progress and News

Wave 2 parishes have now raised over **\$14 million**, which is 49% of their collective goal. Nine parishes have exceeded their goals, with several more on the verge in the coming weeks. This success is a reflection of the excellent leadership pastors have been demonstrating in parish campaigns. Our clergy have also been committing their personal financial support for parish campaigns and have collectively donated or pledged almost **\$1 million**.

Overall, the campaign has now raised gifts and pledges of over **\$63 million** or 60% of the Family of Faith campaign's minimum \$105 million goal.

This is a tremendous achievement since less than half of the parishes in the archdiocese have completed their campaigns. Congratulations to the clergy, volunteers and parishioners from across the archdiocese who are working so hard to ensure the goals of the Family of Faith campaign can be achieved.
