

Campaign Results to Date

Wave 2 parishes have now raised over **\$20 million**, which is **76%** of their collective goal. Many of these campaigns have now been broadly announced in their parishes with several already holding their Commitment Weekends. Overall, the campaign has now raised gifts and pledges of **\$71.9 million** or **69%** of the Family of Faith campaign's minimum \$105 million goal.

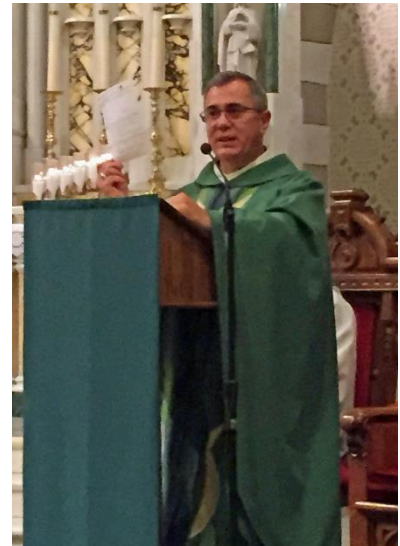
